## Hagley Parish Council Update

#### **Church Street access**

The closure of the access remains essential for health and safety reasons. Whilst the various playing fields works are on-going HPC cannot compromise the safety of the public and will re-open as soon as it's safe to do so. Please accept my apology for any inconvenience caused.

#### The Pavilion

Having made good progress earlier this year lately there has been an unavoidable delay in the works.

This was out of our control and this is primarily due to the withdrawal of one of the major contractors. This meant reappointing a replacement contractor and fitting in with that contractor's existing work book. Measures continue to complete this re-build ASAP.

#### **Playing field**

Bringing the fields back into public use has taken longer than anyone had planned for. The weather has conspired against Severn Trent, where one of the most severe winters was followed by one of the driest and hottest summers on record.

A second application of seeding will be followed by grass mowing and repair until the field is in a position to be handed back for general public use.

Clearly we are not as advanced as we'd hoped to have been with these projects, but we're working as hard as possible to get them completed ASAP. Some unfortunate inconvenience yes, more affected than others, but in the end Hagley will be better for these works in many ways for generations to come.

We began our Autumn Term on Tuesday 04 September, so we've already been playing our new repertoire for over a month and thoroughly enjoying the mixture of JS Bach, Mozart and Sibelius. Our greatest challenge is Dvořák's Quintet for 2 violins, viola, cello and double bass; wonderful music but the only instrument to avoid the considerable technical problems is the D.B.! Although this is really for solo instruments, we're having a go as a smallish group.

We are particularly interested in an unusual arrangement of Haydn's 'London' Symphony. After the death in 1790 of his employer, Count Esterhàzy, Haydn retires with a pension, and meets in Vienna the impresario Salomon who invites him to London. Thus, the following year and aged 59, Haydn has a triumphant time in London with many successful concerts and an honorary Doctorate of Music degree from Oxford University. Whilst on his two visits to the UK, Haydn composed his last twelve symphonies, including the 'Surprise', 'Drumroll', 'Clock', 'Military', and, in 1795, the 'London'. Salomon gained permission to publish arrangements of these symphonies, initially for piano solo, and then for string quintet with flute, and it is this we are playing with Anne Wilson as our flautist.

Dressed in outfits they had selected themselves (a rare event in their life) Ksenaia and Arina thanked the club members for their hospitality and friendship in a speech given in credible English for 12 year olds. The harshness of their life in an area beaten by successive wars and invasions culminating in the nuclear disaster with which the name Chernobyl is most recognized, was both an enjoyable and moving experience.

Also during the summer Rotarian Ann Paraiso provided a brilliant and well-presented talk during with much food for thought for her fellow Rotarians. As a Psychologist in training, Ann outlined the difficulties in the

new world of technology for the young and vulnerable. Appreciating the demands on the younger mind by freeing the intellect with mobile phones, there is a dark side of the media age in which paranoia of the teenage years replaces the playground bullies on a 24/7 cycle. Match this with heavy demands on the NHS for other treatments and medicine, we have major shortage of social mental health support creating a problem in the making as teenagers and vulnerable people, fearing their phone texts, resort to self-harm and suicide to extract themselves from mental harm with cries for help




