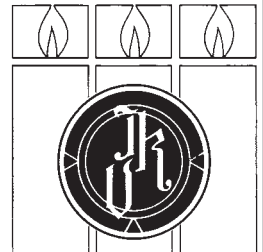

Hagley Parish Council Update

At the time of writing the Launch of the Hagley Neighbourhood Plan is being prepared, starting with the production of 2,500 information leaflets and invitations to four consultation events. I hope you were able to come to one of these meetings and found the evening to be informative and interesting. If you were unable to make the meeting or want to keep abreast of the Plan checkout www.hagleyneighbourhoodplan.org.

This year's 'Christmas in Hagley' event will be held on the evening of the 1st December (Saturday). The Worcester Road from the old Lloyds Bank to Summervale Road will be closed from 4pm to 8pm with only limited access to the shoppers' car park with a walking escort. Diversions to some adjoining roads will be in place just for the duration of the event.

Santa and his elves have been booked and the tree lights will be switched on at 6pm. There will be 'open the book' Christmas story in the Free Church, along with Free trade Christmas Fayre in the Hall. Lookout for Santa as he makes his way around Hagley from around 4pm on the day. More details will follow in the coming weeks.

Councillor Austin and I had the honour of awarding the '2018 Summer Reading Challenge' medals in Hagley Library on the 3rd October. The staff and volunteers at the Library are already planning next year's challenge.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

Inspector Keyte has now moved to a different post across the West Mercia force. His replacement is still to be appointed and as such once again leaves the Hagley Police team under strength.

We wish Inspector Keyte all the best for the future and thank him for his support during his short posting in Hagley.

We are concerned that the frequency of change in the local Police team continually leaves us vulnerable and adds further pressure on the remaining officers. It is a reported nationally how the cuts in the Police force is affecting front line services. Those cuts can be clearly seen in the local Policing team as over the years we have seen first-hand how the reduction in officers and PCSOs has taken effect.

We will contact the Police and Crime Commissioner and seek reassurance that Inspector Keyte will be replaced as a matter of urgency.

At the time of writing the public meeting with the Police is being planned; any issues taken from that meeting will be treated as a Police priority as part of the PACT commitment.

VILLAGE INFORMATION

HAYBRIDGE HIGH SCHOOL



Haybridge High School and Sixth Form's autumn term has started with a focus on practical Citizenship.

We have had record participation in two online student surveys: one to select the charities we will support as a school community in the 2018/19 Academic year and one to gauge the scale of 'single-use' plastic bottle consumption across the student body.

For the past 3 years we have asked students to select a local and national/global charity to be the main recipients of our fundraising efforts. This year the local charity selected is The Basement Project – a youth homelessness charity based in Bromsgrove. The national charity selected is MIND, the Mental Health Charity. Staff from both charities have visited us to launch our partnership and we look forward to generating funds for them and to learning more about their important work.

Few of us can have escaped the mounting global concern over the amount of single-use plastic which ends up polluting the environment, whether the countryside or our seas. 760 students have taken part in our plastics survey and we will be working strategically with students and other stakeholders to tackle the unsustainable levels of plastic bottle usage in our community. Watch this space for updates!

Many thanks to our fantastic Sixth Form Charity team for their work on the hugely successful Macmillan Coffee morning, which raised £280 from delicious baked goods.

Fans of theatre and music take note: the Haybridge production for March 2019 is 'Beauty and The Beast'. We look forward to rehearsals!

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

The latest as regards the opening of the new public footpath between Hagley Primary School and Sanderson Court is that it will not open until Christmas. We are told that this is due to essential works which are due to start on the 5th November. This is long overdue and only brought forward following a question by Cllr Jenkins at a recent full Council meeting.

The delayed and cancelled recycling waste collection in September has been brought to BDC's full Council meeting where a full investigation and review into the events will take place. The finds will be made public following a motion tabled by Cllr Colella.

The Bromsgrove Development Plan Issues and Options consultation has commenced. There is still an opportunity for you to make your comments and views into future development across Bromsgrove known before the consultation closes. For more information go to BDC's website.

A council response has been made to a Government consultation into how the Government funds local authorities. This potentially has the effect of reducing grants to the District Council by £740,000 from as soon as 2020/21 and of course bringing closer scrutiny into the effectiveness of essential front line services. This is a very important issue; we support the current Government grants provision and would be totally against any reduction in grants that BDC currently receives.

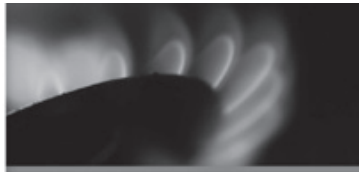
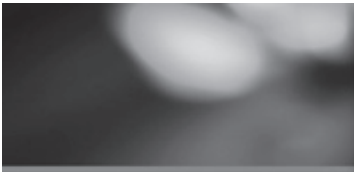

It's good news that we are attracting new members, and have recruited from Double Bass upwards. 'The more the merrier', as this enables us to play a wider variety of music and, most importantly, gaining a buzz in producing satisfying performances – a real pleasure.

We've now had a number of sessions rehearsing JS Bach's *Piano (Harpsichord) Concerto in D minor* with our excellent soloist Tony Bridgewater. Composed around 1721, it is almost certainly an arrangement of a previous work (possibly for violin solo), and influenced by the great Italian violinist-composers Corelli and Vivaldi. Indeed some people believe that the composer is Vivaldi and not Bach. Whatever, it is splendid music and most enjoyable to play.



We've also asked Tony to be a timpanist for Mozart's *Serenate notturna*. This was composed when Mozart was 20 in 1776 and working as court musician to Prince Colloredo in Salzburg. Serenades were written mainly for light entertainment, often as 'background' music whilst people ate, drank and chatted. Composed for two orchestras, one is for strings and timpani, and the other a solo quartet, but with double bass rather than the more usual cello. Why '*notturna*'? Maybe it was for an evening party; it is certainly very jolly.

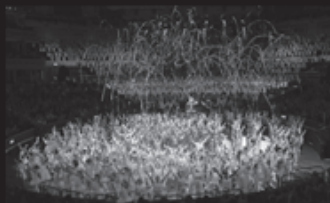
