

## **Hagley Parish Council Update**

Hopefully you'll be reading this before the 1st December and will be able to come to 'Christmas in Hagley'. We are planning to close the Worcester Rd between the Summervale Road junction and the Shoppers car park from 4pm to 8pm. This is for safety reasons and for the enjoyment of the public event. There will be diversion signs for anyone wishing to access or exit the roads affected by the closure. Further details of the evening's events will have been circulated and made readily available.

At the time of writing we are in negotiations with the contractor for the roofing and cladding works on the changing rooms, Severn Trent Water with regard to opening up the playing fields and preparing to open the Church Street access. In each case we are asking for these works to be completed as soon as possible. In the case of the Church Street access there may be times when it will need to be closed when there are deliveries or when there are works immediately next to the access itself.

Thank you to everyone that attended the Neighbourhood Plan meetings, we received some very interesting feedback.

Please note that the Parish offices will be closed on and from the 24thDec and will re-open 7th January 2019.

Thank you to PC Marc Ginder and his PCSO team for attending the meeting on the 17th October and also welcome to new Inspector Chappell. There was a reasonable turnout and I hope that you found it informative and a valuable meeting.

Marc and his team responded to questions in respect of Police roles and responsibilities on parking, speeding as well as updating the meeting on the recent arrests of would-be burglars in Hagley. The successful arrest was made by the night patrol team using both marked and unmarked police vehicles.

Local parking and speeding issues were discussed as well as the trespass to the old shed (now demolished) rear of the Old Lloyds Bank building.

The meeting concluded with a presentation of 'Smart Water' and the practicalities of making it widely available in Hagley.

Just a reminder not to make it easy for would-be criminals - take valuables out of vehicles, leave a light or two on when out after dark, fit intruder alarms and let neighbours know if you're away for any length of time. It's also a good time of year to let your elderly neighbours know that you're thinking about them. Keeping an eye on each other's property has mutual benefits.

I'd like to wish you a very happy and safe Christmas and New Year remember that there are some that like to take advantage of people's Christmas generosity- don't leave presents out for all to see, keep them under lock and key.






## WALKS AROUND HAGLEY-BROOME

DISTANCE 3 AND A HALF MILES. TIME ABOUT 2 HOURS. PARK EITHER AT THE SIDE OF THICKNALL LANE OR NEARBY (O.S. MAP GRID REF. 903793) Notes nettles in high Summer and large dogs will have to be lifted over the first three stiles.

- 1. The walk begins at the lane opposite Thicknall Farm. There is proof of a dwelling here from the 14th. century, William de Thickenol was mentioned in 1327 and Henry Thykenol in 1400. Ticken means young goats (perhaps also lambs) so the farm was possibly the residence of the shepherd who grazed the animals on the adjacent Clent Heath. Walk along this lane and turn left at the T-junction, in a few yards cross the stile on the right and follow the footpath, with the, fence on your left, to the two stiles. Cross these so that the hedge is now on your right.
- 2. There are views of the Clent Hills as you walk to the next stile, onto a track where you turn right.
- 3. Before you take the next turn right stop and view Red Hall Farm. The present house was built in. the late 17th. or early 18th. century using some materials from previous houses on the site. The evidence leads to the assumption that there was a part sandstone and timber-framed building on the site. The name Red Hall means Red Spring and the site has been occupied since 1373, when it belonged to Black Ladies Priory, Brewood and was tenanted by John de Dunclent and his wife Alice.
- 4. Turn right passing the millstone in the bank. Along this lane on your left is Old Well Cottage, formerly Broome Farm. It is the black and white cottage with a cider press in the side/back garden.

 At the junction stop. Broome House (now a private retirement home) is on the left, on the right is the Old School House and beyond it is the Parish Rooms (previously Broome School built in 1889 and closed 1933).

6. Go straight ahead and through the Church yard. The present Church of St. Peter was built in 1780 with 1861 additions, it replaced a medieval church. One of the Rectors was Thomas Dolman, who married Mary Penn from Harborough Hall in 1726, her sister Anne was the mother of William Shenstone the poet and landscape gardener famous for his grounds at the Leasowes, Halesowen. Rejoin the lane.



7. Notice the bargeboards on Rose
Cottage by the Junction. On the left
nearest the junction is Dower Cottage, partly timber framed, which was the temporary Rectory between
1921 and 1924 whilst. the new Rectory was built.


**Optional Diversion.** Turn right to view Broome Farm on the left, note the road sign! Either retrace your steps or circle the centre of Broome.

- At Dower Cottage take the road to Churchill. Note the boundary wall of the Old Rectory. Look for Lords and Ladies in the hedge opposite (in season.) At Hundredacres Farm take the footpath over the ditch and stile, diagonally across the field to the next stile on the A450, which cuts a corner
- 9. Cross the road to the footpath opposite. Just before the path crosses the end of the first field you are passing over the route of the Roman road between Droitwich, Greensforge and Watling Street. Pause at the gap in the hedge for lovely views of Romsley, Walton, Clent and Wychbury. The Hall, Church spire and the Monument at Hagley can. also be seen.


## AGE INFORMATION

- 10. Continue to the T junction at the foot of the steep bank through the wood. Turn right on the far side of the hedge and follow the path to Broome Mill.
- 11. One pool faces you, but is fenced off, turn right, on your right is Broome Mill, now a modernised house. When on the tarmaced drive the raised bank on the right is the dam of the pool which supplied the water for the mill
- 12. Follow the drive to the A456. The 5 acre field on the right, known as "Poor 

  s Land" raised money for the poor by rent or crops until 1949.
- 13. Cross the A456 to the footpath by Harborough Farm. Built between 1832 and 1838, but recently extensively altered. The two cottages on the hill to the left are older.
- 14. At Stakenbridge Lane turn right. The Post Box outside Yarnold Cottages shows which one was once a Post Office. Railway Cottage is one of three built c. 1852.for railway employees. Bay Tree House now stands where cottages for the poor were built in 1805, but sold in 1836 when the poor were sent to Bromsgrove Workhouse. Not a change for the better!



- 15. Dammas House recalls the fact that Dammas Hall was situated on that corner.
- 16. The raised bank on the right of the road, just before the houses begin, is the remains of a tumulus, one of a group excavated by Bishop Lyttelton in the 18th. Century.
- 17. On reaching the A456, on your right is Daisy Cottage. In 1838 this cottage & shop belonged to William Price. Cross the road carefully, into Thicknall Lane, then cross the A450 and return to your car.

## **Hagley String Orchestra**

On 4th December we completed the 13 rehearsals for this Autumn Term, having thoroughly enjoyed a delightfully mixed bag of repertoire. Our greatest challenge this term has been Dvořák's Quintet for first and second violins, viola, cello, and, unusually, a double bass.

Antonin Dvořák (1841-1904) was a Czech composer, whose father, an innkeeper and butcher, regularly played in a folk band. Learning the violin as well as organ and piano, Dvořák joined his father's band playing Bohemian and Moravian folk music. Whilst studying in Prague, he continued to play both violin and viola in orchestras, and became influenced by Smetana's music. Dvořák wrote a 5-movement String 5tet when he was 34, dedicating it 'To My Nation' and entering it for a competition; he got First Prize and 5 ducats! Twelve years later, in 1887, he removed one movement and published it as his Opus 77; it is a strongly



nationalistic work influenced by his experience of folk music. Although technically challenging, we have loved its memorable tunes, dance rhythms, and sheer emotional exuberance.





# BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

It has long since been our view that until the last 3 or 4 years Hagley received very little investment as opposed to elsewhere across the district.

We are delighted to be able to report that with the support of Hagley Parish Council and community groups investment in this area has now topped £800,000. This follows many hours over many years of continued lobbying and pressure being applied through the planning process and the District Council's grant scheme to gain this investment.

We have supported some £92,000 of New Homes Bonus money and a £100,000 grant towards the new Scout Hut. The remainder of the funding total is made up of planning obligations including £75,000 for the skate park, £60,000 for outdoor facilities in the playing fields and the outdoor gym; over £14,500 for car parking in the village centre, some £134,000 for improving the Community Centre, proposed £38,400 for community transport and over £287,000 for wider transport infrastructure across the County.

This direct investment is enhanced with significant 7 figure sums invested in the schools, doctor's surgery building, roads as well as new public footpath alongside the primary school to improve local access and amenity.

Thank you to the village organisations and individuals who have helped us obtain this much needed money to continue to improve Hagley now and in the future.






