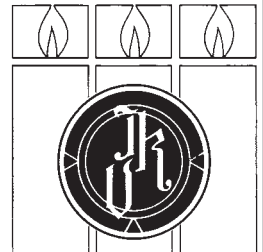

Hagley Parish Council Update

The Christmas event went very well indeed, in my opinion probably the best so far and was a satisfying end to year-long planning by many people.

I would like to thank everyone involved especially the Parish Clerks- Alex and Louise, the District Centre's manager, Severn Area Rescue Association, Spar for providing staff and for supplying hot food and drinks, Hagley Theatre Group and Hagley Primary School choir for keeping us entertained and of course, all the businesses.

Since my last update on the changing rooms we have now a signed contract with the roofing and cladding contractor and working on a start date and completion date for these works. I would like to say that I and fellow Parish Councillors remain very frustrated by the very slow progress but continue to work hard to complete this re-build as soon as possible.

The health and safety advice we continue to receive is that as soon as the roofing works are complete on the changing room the Church Street access will be opened.

Parts of the playing fields have been opened up; the remainder will be fully opened when the weather improves in the spring.

Residents may not be aware but WCC is looking into cutting costs of the Library Services. We will be resisting any further cuts in services and recognise the immense benefit that the Library brings. We intend to hold a public meeting where we can gauge public opinions on the future of our Library.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

Following a meeting with Hagley residents, various comments received as part of local consultations and doorstep visits we have taken quite a bold step by contacting West Mercia's Chief Constable, Superintendent and Crime Commissioner, as well Sajid Javid MP inviting them to attend a crime summit here in Hagley which we've entitled 'Policing in a place like Hagley'.

We hope is that the senior officials will accept the invitation so that a profile of Hagley can be presented along with the most recent reported crime figures in the area and that we can engender some support to bring about actions which will see a positive reduction in crime.

This is a unique call to action but considered absolutely necessary given the continued rise in reported crime and the losses in frontline policing officers.

We will keep you informed if and when we receive acknowledgments to my request.

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

We have long since been aware of the large scale housing development in Wyre Forest, particularly around the Lea Castle and Husum Way areas between Blakedown and Kidderminster. Our concerns relate to the additional traffic that will be generated by these developments passing along the A456 and A491.

Whilst we welcome Wyre Forest District Council's recognition that there is a need for remedial action there are concerns over the deliverability of Highways and Infrastructure investment. There are no fully costed schemes or options that would make the thousands of houses sustainable. The Worcestershire County Local Transport Plan (LTP4) makes no provision for investment past Kidderminster and so makes the overall Development Plan unsafe.

We also welcome objections raised by BDC whose submission questioned many of the measures proposed in the Plan. There is a significant disconnect between Wyre Forest's aspirations and Worcestershire County Council's plans for investment to alleviate not only current traffic congestion but the additional traffic development will bring in the Kidderminster area.

The Wyre Forest Plan raises some welcome recognition of the traffic problems along the A456 and A491. This is a good starting point which will now be high on the agenda over the coming months and years. We are very happy that the long and hard campaigning and lobbying seems to have been listened to in some quarters.

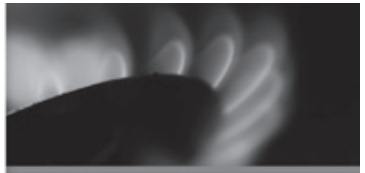
