

VILLAGE INFORMATION



December 3rd 2018 marked the publication of a new expert statement on physical activity and exercise for osteoporosis by the National Osteoporosis Society. The document "Strong, Steady and Straight" aims to clarify what exercise is suitable, safe and recommended for people with the bone thinning condition. It is hoped sufferers will receive better advice on the correct exercises to help strengthen

bones, reduce fracture risk and help with the pain and symptoms associated with spinal fractures.

More than 3 million people in the UK are estimated to have Osteoporosis, a condition that causes around 500,000 broken bones every year – that's one every minute**.

For most older adults post retirement that don't exercise regularly, exercise to improve balance and muscle strength is recommended (2-3 days a week) and if your balance isn't as good as you would like or you have had any falls you should seek a trained exercise professional to access specific and highly challenging balance and muscle strengthening exercises. So if you are one of those people or you are just concerned about your bone health what should you do? Active Seniors have very experienced instructors available to tailor exercise to the individual needs of the client and have several strength and balance classes as well as Tai Chi for Health classes at Hagley Community Centre.


Hagley Library Healthy Walking Group

Hagley Parish Council Update

At the time of writing WCC is undergoing a public consultation into the likely cuts in Library and bus services.

For Hagley Library this is likely to mean proposals which will see cuts to staff, pressures to reduce opening hours, automation and other cost cutting measures. We have resolved to do everything we can to resist these cuts and intend to hold a meeting with WCC and a public meeting as regards measures we can take to protect this service. HPC has already taken over the maintenance and up keep of the Library with a fantastic group of volunteers supporting the staff and management.

The bus consultation is likely to see further cuts to the service putting the already limited service at risk. This is an opportune time to remind you of our own dial-a-ride community bus and how easy and convenient it is for local travel to local shopping centres.

We are continuing to face contractual problems with the Pavilion roofing and cladding contractor. We continue to work hard to resolve these as quickly as possible.

With the end of winter almost in site the final preparations are being made for the complete opening of the playing fields depending on the remaining winter conditions over the next few weeks.

At the time of writing we are undertaking our budget preparation for 2019/20 precept. Details will be made available in due course.

As a further reminder and date for your diary our AGM is to be held on the 25th March in the Free Church hall.







Hagley Historical and Field Society



Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 5th February 2019 at 8.00pm when we will have a presentation by Ken Knowles entitled "The Town Crier of Lichfield".

Ken is a colourful character who has been Town Crier and sword bearer for the city of Litchfield for the past eight years. He cried his way to victory after winning an ancient contest of Criers from across the UK. He was judged to be the country's best Crier under Ancient and Honourable Guild of Town Criers rules on accuracy, diction, volume and inflection at the contest in Alcester. He will address us in full regalia. Will it be the traditional eighteenth century red and gold coat, white breeches, black boots and a tricorne hat?

It is thought that the post of Town Crier came over from Normandy with William the Conqueror in 1066. The traditional proclamation of "Oyez" is derived from the old Norman for "Listen to This". Prior to widespread literacy, town criers were the means of communication with the people of the town as many could neither neither read nor write. Proclamations, local bylaws, market days and adverts were all proclaimed by the crier. In Goslar, Germany, a crier was employed to remind townsfolk not to put "anything unpleasant" into the river the day before water was drawn for brewing beer!

Hagley String Orchestra

HSO aims to give our players each week as much enjoyment as possible in playing a wide range of music together, some of it familiar, and some of it new to many. Thus we learn more about string repertoire without the inevitable pressure and stress in preparing for a public performance. Our music making is therefore private and simply for our own pleasure.

I mentioned in last month's Issue that this term our music ranges from the 17th to 20th centuries. A work unknown to most of us is Little Music by Sir Michael Tippett (1905-1998). With his contemporary Benjamin Britten, Tippett became the leading British composer of the day. In 1940 he became Director of Music at Morley College, London, which had on the staff a number of refugee musicians from Nazi Germany. Perhaps his best-known work is the Oratorio A Child of Our Time (1941) based on the murder of a German diplomat in Paris by a Jewish refugee; this event triggered 'Kristallnacht' when the Nazis attacked Jews.



In London at this time was a highly-regarded string orchestra founded in 1936 by Reginald Jacques. To celebrate this orchestra's 10th Anniversary in 1946, Tippett wrote Little Music which begins with a slow Prelude leading to a Fugue, which in turn leads to an Air based on a typically Purcellian ground bass. This 11 minute work concludes with a sparkling Vivace which ends surprisingly with a brilliant fortissimo passage echoed as quietly as possible as a jokey end.



Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

At the last Hagley Neighbourhood Watch public meeting a presentation was made on SmartWater. For those that were unable to attend the meeting this is a water-based, invisible organic liquid that can be traceable through an ultraviolet light. It is invisible to the naked eye and contains a unique forensic signature from which can be traced back to where the item came from. For example unique SmartWater is registered to the property. Valuables are then marked with the water along with the owners details. Only a small amount is required and in the event that the actual item is stolen if the property is recovered it can be returned to its rightful owner. This can then be linked back to the scene of crime. This product has been widely distributed both nationally and internationally.

Having signed up for this product to be rolled out across the area street signs are also deployed warning would be criminals that properties in this area have been marked with SmartWater. Research does show that this is a good deterrent and has shown some very good recovery results.

The rollout of SmartWater is planned for March/April. Watch out for more information.

At the time of writing there has been no response to the request for Crime Summit to be held in Hagley from our MP, senior Police Officers or the PCC.

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

Wyre Forest District Council has recently completed the final public consultation stage of the plan for their District, including c3000 new homes around the A456 near Offmore/Husum Way and A449 at Lea Castle.

For the first time their consultation included bypasses for Mustow Green and Hagley. Whilst the recognition of the need for a bypass is welcomed in principle the inclusion at this late stage feels like an afterthought.

Councillor Jenkins and I spoke at a recent BDC Cabinet meeting to support BDC's formal objection arguing there was a failure to include fully costed and evidenced details of how the significant extra traffic through Hagley would be mitigated by road improvements.

Objections to this stage of the planning process were supported by BDC planners is an unprecedented step recognising that the Wyre Forest plan is 'unsound and unsafe'.

NEST6

Worcestershire County Council is required to produce, deliver and maintain a local transport plan (called LTP4 2018 to 2031).

Within that plan are improvement schemes including Hagley called NEST6 which commits to; a complete review of a number of junctions in Hagley to assess capacity, traffic flows, design and signalling apparatus and to identify whether capacity and/or safety improvements is required.

An FOI request showed that the review had identified capacity and/or safety improvements were required and that improvement schemes would be implemented in 2018.

However, this has not happened and the elements within the plan have been dismissed and as such WCC has failed to comply with its statutory obligations.


