

VILLAGE INFORMATION



Last month we discussed strength – this month its time to talk about balance!

Noun : Balance an even distribution of weight enabling someone or something to remain upright and steady.

So what do we need to do to retrain our balance?

1. Reduce base of support - feet closer or in tandem

2. Reduce hold on support whilst doing challenging balance exercises

3. Move weight around – e.g. moving a raised limb around whilst performing balance challenges

Sound complicated? - lets explain!

To improve your balance you need to challenge your balance - normal walking won't do this!

We need to incorporate challenges such as:

One legged stands, walking heel to toe on a narrow line, tiptoe walking, walking backwards and side stepping to name but a few simple ones. As we get better at them we need to increase the challenge and reduce any hold we have.

Our strength and balance classes are designed to improve our balance by progressively making the balance exercises more difficult. Tai Chi also helps our balance as it is multi directional and we become more aware of weight transference.

It might be mid summer's night but our attentions are beginning to turn to the 2019 Christmas in Hagley event. Last year's change to a Saturday evening seemed to work very well and the introduction of a few extra Christmas themed stalls and additional entertainments were popular additions.

Later this summer Worcestershire County Council will be announcing the outcome of its Library Services consultation. The consultation was in response to WCC budget reviews and identified which areas of its services would face budget cuts. HPC recognises the importance of our Library and will respond fully when the outcome of the consultation is known.

The Library continues to be supported by a fantastic group of volunteers, HPC and WCC staff by continuing to maintain the Library's opening hours and services as well as carrying out essential maintenance.

HPC has one eye on the future of the Village with its support for the Neighbourhood Plan group. The group is currently in the process of producing a Hagley census. Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 2nd July 2019 at 8.00pm when we will have a presentation by Max Hunt entitled "Herbert Austin and Longbridge". Max was a former history master and later Director of Education for Stockport. He was born in Romsley and remembers the special trains taking

Austin workers home from Longbridge stopping at Hunnington Station. His first car was an Austin Seven 'Nippy' made at Longbridge in 1935.

Whether you are interested cars or not, I think this will be an interesting and maybe nostalgic evening. 'The Austin' at Longbridge as it is still fondly remembered, was a local manufacturer which has employed many tens of thousands of Midlanders since 1906 and many of us will have family members who were employed there and possibly driven one of the vehicles made there. I can make a claim on both counts.

Although Herbert Austin died in 1941 the story of Longbridge, once Europe's largest car factory, continued through the fifties and sixties when the factory was under the control of William Lord. Cars were styled by Battista Pininfarina and Alex Issigonis. The latter developed the Mini launched in 1959 and the highly successful Austin 1100. Unfortunately, it is a story which does not have a happy ending.

Hagley String Orchestra

We enjoy playing music from different periods, for example Baroque, Classical, Romantic and Modern. This term we have played sextets by William Lawes (1602-1645).

William's elder brother was Henry (1596-1662), and both became successful composers in the Court of King Charles I. William's string music was written to be played by Consorts of Viols as traditional for the King's Musick. These instruments were popular in Europe from the 15th century. Most were flat-backed with 6 strings, and the sound is relatively quiet, thin and pure, and all were played cello-style, the smallest Trebles resting on the knee. However, in Italy some 90 years earlier, the superb luthier Andrea Amati (c.1520-1578) had established violin making in Cremona to be followed by Stradivarius and others.

Thus William and Henry Lawes in London were using string instruments that were becoming old-fashioned in Europe, and the richer more versatile violin family of instruments was gaining



dominance. Nowadays, there are professional Consorts of Viols that specialise in performing this music. We're playing on our modern instruments.

With the outbreak of the Civil War in 1642, Lawes joined the Royalist army and he was shot near Chester in 1645 dying aged 43.

On the Ropes!

The recent training day at Kidderminster St. Mary & All Saints was very informative. Dee, Yvonne and I were put

through our paces by the trainer David Struckett. It was great to have confirmation that the training methods for beginners at Hagley fitted in with David's. I picked up some valuable tips on how to teach bell/rope control to new ringers. From the first practice attended new ringers learn the back stoke. Yvonne, who has now been to three practices, is just getting the confidence to move on to ringing by pulling the coloured part of the rope known as the sally. Each step is demonstrated before you have a go yourself under supervision. It's about technique and timing rather than strength.

Dee, one of our "Ringing Remembers" recruits, was shown some valuable tips on how to get the bells into the up position and back down again.

The bell chamber at Hagley is only accessible via a ladder then scrambling up though two trap doors. Those attending this recent training event at Kidderminster were easily able to see the magnificent bells and the very simple mechanism that the ropes control, as one of the bells was rung into the up position. A very loud experience, so it was a "fingers in your ears to lessen the decibel level" for you.

Parishes of Belbroughton with Fairfield, Client, Broome, Churchill and Blakedown

The civil parish of Broome is a small rural parish in the north-east of the county, an area a little under two square miles, and with a population of under 300. It comprises two old settlements, the village of Broome and the hamlet of Yieldingtree. The ecclesiastical parish is much larger, with over twice the population, and extends right into the village of West Hagley to the north.

The village itself lies hidden from the major roads and is as pretty a village as one could wish, with snowdrops and daffodils along the verges in spring, a pond with waterfowl, many fine trees, and well kept gardens with flowering shrubs. The school, which closed in 1933, was converted into a village hall.

The little red-brick church, dedicated to St Peter, was built in 1780. In its beautifully cared for interior is the original font, and on the walls some interesting memorials, including an early 19th century memorial tablet carved by John Flaxman. It has a beautiful open churchyard.
