



How many of you out there have thought about how strong your bones are?

Is there perhaps a family history of osteoporosis or have you had a fracture yourself as a result of a trip or fall from standing height or less?

Hagley Historical and Field Society



Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 1st October 2019 at 8.00pm. After a short AGM, we will have a lively and animated talk by Max Keen in full period costume on one of his all-time heroes - Prince Rupert of the Rhine: King Charles I's Pirate Prince.

A nephew of King Charles I, Rupert was one of the English Civil War's most paradoxical heroes. Handsome, impetuous and courageous, he was the epitome of the 'Cavalier', yet he was born a German prince and a protestant. As the Royalist General of Horse, he was a brilliant strategist, but a volatile and impetuous tactician, who frequently appeared in Worcestershire. He also served the royalist cause as an Admiral and in later life commanded fleets against the Dutch.

On Tuesday 5th November 2019 we will have a presentation on 'The Earl of Dudley's Railway' by Ned Williams.

In 1829, while George Stephenson was building his "Rocket," the Earl of Dudley ran "Agenoria" on his pioneering Black Country railway linking his collieries with the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal. Although it rarely carried passengers, this railway grew into a huge complex industrial system that centred on the Earl's Round Oak Steel Works at Brierley Hill. This talk covers the system, as well as its history, the locomotives and men who served the line, including how this all relates to the remains that can be seen today.

Hagley String Orchestra

We've chosen the *String Quartet in A minor* by Johannes Brahms (1833-1897) as our chamber music piece for this Autumn Term, to be played by the whole string orchestra. He began work on this quartet in 1865 when he was 32, and he worked at it for six years before allowing a performance in 1873.

I was surprised and delighted when players asked if we could rehearse Brahms *Clarinet Quintet* as an extra piece on 27 August. Being holiday time, some members were away, so we invited some experienced players to join us with clarinettist, Pauline Eldridge, playing the demanding solo part.

When Brahms was 49 he was invited to be the soloist in the premiere of his *Piano Concerto No. 2* with the elite Meiningen Court Orchestra, and subsequently he conducted his *Symphony No. 4* with them.

Aged 52, he decided to retire from composing but, six years later in 1891, he became inspired to compose this wonderful piece for clarinet and string quartet by the superb clarinettist of the Meiningen Orchestra, Richard Mühfeld. During his life he loved several women but never married stating "I am incapable of bearing fetters". For many years he supported Clara Schumann and her family after the death in 1856 of her husband Robert. He was 58 and alone when he composed this rather sombre Quintet, dying of cancer five years later aged 63.

Lee Hale's talk to our August meeting about Winterbourne House and Garden (in Edgbaston) shone light on the determination, imagination and fund-raising that it takes to convert a family home into a public treasure. The house in this case was built in the 1900s as the home of the Nettlefolds and bequeathed with its gardens to the University of Birmingham in 1944.



The season of mists and mellow fruitfulness is on us again, and what better time for the garden visits we made in Oxfordshire in early September. Our first stop was at Aston Pottery gardens, where borders planted with asters, dahlias, salvias and grasses give the autumn visitor a feast for the eyes before the frosts of winter. In this talk Simon focuses on gardens in the Midlands and North West and will look at how the National Trust manage their historic gardens and the plant collections they contain.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

This month I have taken reports from the Hagley & Rubery Safer Neighbourhood Team's reports. Reported at the end of July was the return of an old scam of selling TVs from the back of a van. The report reminds people that selling anything from the back of vehicles can only be suspicious and should be resisted even if the cost seems be too good to be true – it probably is.

There was a spike in thefts from motor vehicles in Hagley. Items such as purses, cash, credit card and make up were stolen. Whilst there is an enormous amount of sympathy for the victim the question must be asked why? Why leave valuables in vehicles?

There continue to be scams related to fraud, both on-line fraud and fraud by Bogus Couriers, Bogus Police and Bank Officials. If you're contacted by someone claiming to be officials when you're not expecting them don't engage with them, close the door or put the phone down and call 101.

There have been some positive reports of individuals being charged with burglary, theft and aggravated burglary in Hagley and subsequently sentenced.

Remember that opportunistic thieves look for unlocked/open windows and doors, unlocked sheds, tools, bikes and valuables left unattended. Be alert to strangers in places where you wouldn't usually expect to see them.

At the time of writing plans are being prepared for another Neighbourhood Watch public meeting. More details to follow.

Celebrate Joyous Occasions

Popular superstition in the 12th Century alleged that church bells could ring by themselves – indeed, when Thomas a Becket was murdered, it was said that the bells of Canterbury Cathedral tolled themselves. No such evidence of this happening at our church up by Hagley Hall – the St. Johns bells need a helping hand to make themselves heard!

Historically, bells were rung to call people to church for services and this still happens up at St. Johns on most Sunday mornings, but bells can also ring for other reasons. We ring to celebrate joyous occasions such as for weddings and royal events. We occasionally ring to note a sad occasion, such as tolling for a funeral. We sometimes ring when events are being held in the church, such as the Haybridge High School Carol Service in December. And in line with all other churches nationally, we ring to record significant historic moments – during World War II, British church bells were silenced, to be rung only to inform the country of an invasion by enemy troops, but nowadays, we are requested to ring to commemorate anniversaries dating back to the war. For example, the early May Day bank holiday for 2020 has been moved to Friday 8th May to coincide with the 75th anniversary of VE Day, or Victory in Europe Day, and churches across the country will be taking part in Ringing Out For Peace. We shall be ready and willing to play our part!

Broome Fairfield church Broome

The civil parish of Broome is a small rural parish in the north-east of the county, an area a little under two square miles, and with a population of under 300. It comprises two old settlements, the village of Broome and the hamlet of Yieldingtree. The ecclesiastical parish is much larger, with over twice the population, and extends right into the village of West Hagley to the north.

The village itself lies hidden from the major roads and is as pretty a village as one could wish, with snowdrops and daffodils along the verges in spring, a pond with waterfowl, many fine trees, and well-kept gardens with flowering shrubs. The school, which closed in 1933, was converted into a village hall.

The little red-brick church, dedicated to St Peter, was built in 1780. In its beautifully cared for interior is the original font, and on the walls some interesting memorials, including an early 19th century memorial tablet carved by John Flaxman. It has a beautiful open churchyard.
