



VILLAGE NEWS

Hagley Historical and Field Society



Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 5th November 2019 at 8.00pm when we will have a presentation on 'The Earl of Dudley's Railway' by Ned Williams.

In 1829, while George Stephenson was building his "Rocket," the Earl of Dudley ran "Agenoria" on his pioneering Black Country railway linking his collieries with the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal. Although it rarely carried passengers, this railway grew into a huge complex industrial system that centred on the Earl's Round Oak Steel Works at Brierley Hill. This talk covers the system, as well as its history, the locomotives and men who served the line, including how this all relates to the remains that can be seen today.

On Tuesday 3rd December 2019 we will be enjoying a presentation of 'Christmas Songs Through the Ages: From Boar's Head to Bing' by Richard Churchley.

Richard is an experienced local historian, specialising in areas of Worcestershire, Warwickshire and North Gloucestershire. He combines his historical and academic research interests with performing music, both solo and in various bands, playing a wide variety of instruments. This promises to be a festive and entertaining evening.

Hagley String Orchestra

We're playing two contrasting Serenades by different composers. Apart from lovers serenading their sweethearts on romantic summer evenings, the musical term as used by Mozart and others meant instrumental works to be played in the evenings, sometimes out of doors, using small groups and comprising several movements, not as 'serious' as symphonies.

Czech composer Josef Suk (1874-1935) was 18 when he wrote his *Serenade* and studying with Dvořák, and his teacher's influence can be heard in the music. Not only did Suk become Dvořák's favourite pupil, but also his son-in-law. The four movements of this attractive piece are often emotional as well as being technically and musically demanding.



More light-hearted music comes from Italian Ermanno Wolf-Ferrari

(1876-1948). Born in Venice, his first aim was to be a painter like his father, but aged 17 he studied composition in Munich, where he dedicated his *Serenade for Strings* to his teacher Rheinberger. He became well-known as a successful composer of comic operas such as *Susanna's Secret* (smoking...) and *The Jewels of the Madonna* which was popular at Covent Garden's Royal Opera.

St. John's Hand & Tower Bellringers

St. John's Tower Bell-ringing

Looking to fill a dark evening as we head through the autumn? Why not try your hand at the ancient art of bell-ringing?

From initially learning how to safely handle an individual bell, you progress to ringing as part of the team. Once ringing confidently in rounds (i.e. ringing the bells in order, from the highest-sounding bell, the treble, to the lowest-sounding bell, the tenor), someone in the team then starts calling a change in the order so the bells swap round to make a different tune or pattern (known as call-changing). Once call-changing has been mastered, the next step is to ring a known "method" – methods have been devised over the years by past generations of bell-ringers, to rearrange the order of how the bells ring, in a pre-set pattern. You learn your specific pattern for the bell that you are ringing and off you go - one or two methods are reasonably straightforward, most not remotely! We beaver away at our hobby on Wednesday evenings and by the end of the night, one or more of us may have made progress. But just as importantly, we will have had a laugh as we beaver.

Whilst looking online for assistance with the method that we are currently trying to master, I found a bell-ringing joke: Pavlov hears a bell ring. He says, "Ah, I forgot to feed the dogs again"!

Practice night is on a Wednesday, 7.30-9.00pm, although an individual session can be arranged outside of this time. Come and have a go, contact Richard Scarth 07768273545

Broome Fairfield church Broome

The civil parish of Broome is a small rural parish in the north-east of the county, an area a little under two square miles, and with a population of under 300. It comprises two old settlements, the village of Broome and the hamlet of Yieldingtree. The ecclesiastical parish is much larger, with over twice the population, and extends right into the village of West Hagley to the north.

The village itself lies hidden from the major roads and is as pretty a village as one could wish, with snowdrops and daffodils along the verges in spring, a pond with waterfowl, many fine trees, and well-kept gardens with flowering shrubs. The school, which closed in 1933, was converted into a village hall.

The little red-brick church, dedicated to St Peter, was built in 1780. In its beautifully cared for interior is the original font, and on the walls some interesting memorials, including an early 19th century memorial tablet carved by John Flaxman. It has a beautiful open churchyard.
