

Hagley Parish Council Update

I would like to be one of the first to wish you a very merry Christmas and a prosperous New Year on behalf of everyone at Hagley Parish Council. The count down to the 2019 Christmas in Hagley event is now only a matter of days away (7th December).

A newsletter has been distributed to all households in Hagley detailing the evening's timetable and the route that Santa will be taking as he makes his way to the village centre. The light switch on will be the main event with support from carol singing, Morris dancers and live music.

The main road through the 'High Street' will be closed which will mean that there will be restricted access to adjoining residential roads whilst the event is on-going. The road will begin to be closed at around 4pm and re-open at 8pm.

The playing field works carried out by the Severn Trent contractor will now be assessed over the coming weeks. If it is agreed that the playing fields have been returned to the quality of the amenity before the sewer works the contractor will be stood down.

A further funding bid is being prepared to be submitted to the Football Foundation to fill the funding shortfall. As everyone is aware we have reached a position where the project has stalled due to a number of issues none least due to a funding shortfall. Every effort is being made to find additional financial support and everyone at HPC is working flat out to address these issues.

Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

A meeting was called by parents in respect of the rise in Anti-Social Behaviour, its impacts on the wider community and the role that Haybridge High School and authorities can play in tackling this behaviour.

A summary of the most recent ASB was circulated for discussion. It was noted that the main core of those responsible are not new to Hagley and have come through the school system whist there are also some youths coming into Hagley from neighbouring towns.

It was acknowledged that the Schools do take their role in community stewardship very seriously repeatedly stressing to students how they should behave not only in school but also in the community. The group acknowledged that the overwhelming numbers of students are a credit to Hagley, the schools, parents and the community but unfortunately it was a very small group responsible for these events.

The group committed to investigating the reports and seriously exploring what it can do. It was acknowledged that these were serious matters and a full range of measures were discussed on how to tackle these incidents outside the school gates.

Bullying and intimidation, both physical and through social media was discussed and how one particular person has been severely affected. It was agreed that actions should be taken to support this person to build confidence and self-esteem.

A further follow up meeting was agreed in to be held in November.

BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL UPDATE

Councillors have responded to the latest stages of the Bromsgrove District Development Plan. As previously raised Hagley faces likely development pressures from Bromsgrove's housing needs as well as longer term pressures from the West Midlands Combined Authorities (Birmingham) and increased traffic from development in Wyre Forest and Worcestershire that commutes and travels into the Birmingham and Black Country conurbations.

These impacts are regularly raised with BDC Strategic Planners and we are pleased to report that the district council has raised significant concerns and objections to the latest stages of the Wyre Forest Development Plan re-consultation. These concerns are significant in that they support our objections, those of Hagley Parish Council, the Neighbourhood Plan group and the general public.

Such an objection from a neighbouring planning authority in the same County that come under the same Local Transport Plan is significant. Concerns raised in respect of lack of a robust transport plan to mitigate pressures from Wyre Forest growth on Hagley will ultimately be a matter for consideration by an independent planning inspector.

A District wide 'call for sites' has now closed. The response from land owners and developers is now being considered and will feed into the next stages of the Bromsgrove District Development Plan.

We continue to believe that Hagley is overstretched and over capacity in many of its amenities and services including the road infrastructure and continued development is not viable or sustainable.



Hagley Historical and Field Society



Our next meeting at St Saviour's Church Hall is on Tuesday 3rd December 2019 when we will be enjoying a presentation of 'Christmas Songs Through the Ages: From Boar's Head to Bing' by Richard Churchley.

Richard is an experienced local historian, specialising in areas of Worcestershire, Warwickshire and North Gloucestershire. He combines his historical and academic research interests with performing music, both solo and in various bands, playing a wide variety of instruments. This promises to be a festive and entertaining evening.

On Tuesday 7th January we welcome Mary Bodfish who will be presenting 'Easy as ABC'.

Every time we pick up a pen, or put a finger to keyboard, we link back to the priest-kings of ancient Mesopotamia. A journey of over 5,000 years via Babylon, Egypt, Phoenicia, Greece and Rome shows how our writing system reached this country and how we have been using it since.

Mary spent her working life in bookselling and then in university administration, but days off frequently found her rummaging happily in record offices and libraries. The world of the past has fascinated Mary from her earliest memories; and exploring it continues to absorb her in retirement. Mary is now the chairman of the Smethwick History Society and teaches local history research and palaeography for the University of Birmingham's School of Continuing Studies.

Hagley String Orchestra

Ending our Autumn Term on Tuesday 3rd December, we played two very contrasting pieces. The earlier of the two is a 7-part work *Novelletten* by the Danish composer Niels Gade (1817-1890). Born in Copenhagen, he studied the violin, playing in the Court Orchestra. When he was 26 he got funding from the Danish Government to travel abroad, going to Leipzig where he met Mendelssohn, conducting the premiere of Mendelssohn's Violin Concerto with the famous Gewandhaus Orchestra. At 44 he became Court Kapellmeister in Copenhagen, composing his *Novelletten* thirteen years later in 1874.

Gade was 61 when Rutland Boughton (1878-1960) was born in England, and he studied at the Royal College of Music with Stanford and Walford Davies. When he was 27, Bantock invited him to teach at the Birmingham School of Music, now the Royal Birmingham



Conservatoire. In 1911 he left Birmingham for Glastonbury where he wanted to build a Music Theatre, but the advent of WW1 stopped this. However, the following year he composed *Three Folk Dances for Strings* and his most popular opera *The Immortal Hour* which was first performed at Glastonbury. We've been enjoying his Hornpipe, Folk Song and Country Dance.

His talk took us on a journey through the Midlands showing a number of well



Broome Fairfield church Broome

The civil parish of Broome is a small rural parish in the north-east of the county, an area a little under two square miles, and with a population of under 300. It comprises two old settlements, the village of Broome and the hamlet of Yieldingtree. The ecclesiastical parish is much larger, with over twice the population, and extends right into the village of West Hagley to the north.

The village itself lies hidden from the major roads and is as pretty a village as one could wish, with snowdrops and daffodils along the verges in spring, a pond with waterfowl, many fine trees, and well-kept gardens with flowering shrubs. The school, which closed in 1933, was converted into a village hall.

The little red-brick church, dedicated to St Peter, was built in 1780. In its beautifully cared for interior is the original font, and on the walls some interesting memorials, including an early 19th century memorial tablet carved by John Flaxman. It has a beautiful open churchyard.
