Bromsgrove District Council Update

The New Homes Bonus scheme for 20/21 has closed. I'm pleased to report that Hagley Ramblers Scout Group received a grant towards new stores at the Scout Hut; Cllr Colella received a small grant towards a tree planting scheme and Cllr Colella (with the support of Cllr Kent) received a grant for signage to be erected outside schools encouraging motorist to turn off engines whilst parked.

I'm also pleased to report that my proposed extensive tree planting scheme across the district has been accepted by BD Council and has gone to Cabinet for final approval.

There are a couple of very important Government 'White Papers' which will undoubtedly affect Hagley. The first being Planning review; this is Government's ideas for delivering new housing through planning reform. It has an annual target nationally to deliver 300,000 new houses each year for the next 10 years or so by streamlining current planning processes based on planning for development, planning for infrastructure and planning for beautiful and sustainable places. I'm very concerned with the outcomes of this paper and have made my representations known as part of the consultation. The implications for the district is that the housing target could easily be doubled.

Secondly a Paper on devolution which basically looks to restructure local government. You may know that I'm a long-time supporter that local decision making should be closer to home. I favour a two-tier governance structure i.e. Parish Councils at grassroots level, making local decisions and a 'super' North Worcestershire district council.

This monthly update and the Facebook page tend to focus on crime and Anti-social behaviour but over the lockdown and summer the number of complaints of speeding, dangerous, careless driving and complaints about the many failings of the A456 and A491 being received has increased dramatically.

To this end representation has regularly been made to the Policing chiefs including the Police and Crime Commissioner. Had this been in normal times I would have called a public meeting, but as it's not, an outdoor drop-in session has been agreed by the Policing team for later in September. This will be advertised widely, and I would hope that the opportunity will be taken to visit the police with your various complaints and concerns.

If regular similar meetings are required later in the year, please let me know, failing that I know the policing team are only too happy to engage with the public when they're on patrol in Hagley.

I would like to reiterate that the Policing Team themselves are doing a fantastic job in very difficult circumstances and they have my personal support and thanks for everything that they do.

Hagley Parish Council Update

I would like to start this month's update with a 'thank you' to the editor of the Village News and all the distributors for re-starting the delivery of the Village News. It's a welcome sight and although there has been an electronic version online having a hard copy to read gives some resemblance of returning to normality. For those that didn't read any online updates during the summer I'm sure they can still be read online.

You'll have seen that the playing fields have been re-leveled and the compacted soil mechanically loosened to correct the surface water drainage issues. The field has been re-seeded and we now hope that the late summer rain, which held up works, will return!

The changing room works have been waiting for the solicitors from HPC and the Football Foundation to exchange all the final legalities. Everything else is ready to go, so when this update is being read I'm very hopeful that works will have commenced.

The new dial-a-ride community bus terms of agreement have been presented to HPC with a tentative re-start date being agreed ASAP when Government guidance allows it. We have received s106 monies from recent developments which will financially secure the service for years to come. I would encourage the service to be used as much as possible. I'm particularly excited that there is a plan to extend the 'service' in Hagley which will allow a wider use of the service.



BLAKEDOWN & HAGLEY BRANCH POPPY APPEAL 2020

We have already confirmed that there will be no Poppy Appeal in the area covered by our Branch in 2020, due to the CoVid Pandemic restrictions. There will be no Church Service and no Parade. Admission to the War Memorial will be restricted to those taking part in the service, flag bearers and those laying wreathes, by pre-booked ticket. If you would like to purchase a wreath and obtain a ticket for the event, please contact Jonathan Plant on (07813) 785496 no later than 17th October, but this will have to be first come, first served as the amount of space is limited. Given that there is no Poppy Appeal in the area this year, any donations would be very welcome – please contact Jonathan Plant on the number above for details about cheque or Bank Transfer Payments. We do not have facilities to accept cash donations this year.

I am sure that there will be space on the footpath outside the War Memorial, but we must ask additional attendees that they comply with social distancing requirements, and we will not be able to assist with arrangements. As we are not using the public highway, there will be no measures in place to control traffic at the roundabout.

On Wednesday 11th November, we will be holding a short Service of Remembrance at 11am at Churchill War Memorial, and the laying of wreaths. The war memorial is open to the crossroads, and the road is relatively quiet, so we do not anticipate any issues in view of the limited number expected at this event.

As The Royal British Legion, there was never an option that we would not commemorate the 69 residents of Hagley, Churchill, Blakedown & Broome that have given their lives in conflict over the last 106 years, albeit on a much reduced scale in 2020. We hope to return in 2021, to celebrate The Royal British Legion's 100th Birthday, and hope that this can return to our traditional commemoration.

Telephone Appointments

We continue to operate a telephone appointment system at the surgery and have found this to have some really successful outcomes for both the patients and the Doctors. Telephone appointments are booked for all enquiries initially with the Doctor making a clinical decision as to whether a face to face follow up will be required at the surgery.

All appointments (including telephone slots and selected nurse appointments for smears or blood tests for example) can all be booked online where you have online access to your medical record. It is really easy to do – to sign up for this either download the 'NHSapp' from the app store and follow the simple instructions or speak to reception to be set up with Patient Access. You can access appointment booking or order repeat prescriptions at anytime from anywhere so it really is worthwhile signing up.

Flu campaign

It is really important to make sure you are protected against the flu this winter season. We will be starting vaccinating those patients who are most vulnerable which include;

- adults 65 and over
- people with long term medical conditions including diabetes, heart and respiratory disease (including children in at-risk groups from 6 months of age)
- pregnant women
- children aged 2 and 3
