





The Cross Keys Public House


Hagley has a long history of popular drinking establishments, one of which was located at the junction of the Worcester Road and Kidderminster Road South, opposite the Shell filling station. There had been a boot sales/repair shop and private house there since before 1838. By 1855 alcoholic drinks were sold and the building became known as the Cross Keys Public House.

The photograph shows Mrs. Harriet Grazebrook in a gig (a light carriage pulled by a horse). Her husband John Philips Grazebrook, who is probably holding the reins, was a Black Country ironmaster. The inset enlargement shows the Crossed Keys above the pub entrance. They lived at The Court which was located approximately where Kinver Drive meets the Kidderminster Road. Their sixtieth wedding anniversary was commemorated by their friends with the presentation of a drinking fountain; it now stands on Park Road, overlooking the large roundabout. The pub was converted to private housing in 1994.




Art Club



Interview

Welcome to the latest 'in the company of' feature in the Village News whereby I interview people that make Hagley tick and make the community what it is.

Ten minutes in the company of ... Alan Hess (Probus Club)

Alan is Birmingham born, moving into Hagley via Pedmore in 1969. Raising a family of three with wife Sue, Alan has been an active member of the Probus Club since he retired 12 years ago after a lifetime as a Chartered Accountant.

Probus Clubs are for retired or semi-retired business or professional people from all walks of life. The movement operates worldwide. Meeting new people, making new friends, discovering new interests are just some of the advantages of being a member.

Alan is also involved with the Hagley Community Association as its Treasurer as well as being a former member of Clent Parish Council.

I asked Alan to start by giving me some background into the Probus Club in Hagley and what it stood for. "The name stands for 'Professional Business.' Formed in Hagley in 1981, it is made up of retired people who get together once a month for lunch at The Granary, near Kidderminster, and enjoy a variety of after dinner speakers" said Alan.

Alan went on to give more details of the Club "Probus Clubs can be found internationally where each club is autonomous and has its own committee made up of chairman, treasurer and secretary etc. This enables each club to be flexible and remain separate."

"There were 45 members when I first joined but, unfortunately, it's now down to about 35. Originally, membership was restricted to people from Hagley but now we've spread further and have members from other local areas." I asked Alan about the speakers and activities. "In addition to speakers on a wide range of subjects we go on trips to local National Trust Homes and places of interest as well as going further afield. We also enjoy, theatre visits and an annual 3-night break both in the UK and abroad. The trips are good, enjoyable social affairs for members and partners."

I asked the inevitable question of how Covid has affected the Club "We've not met since March. Being optimistic, I'd like to think that we can meet again in January for our AGM, but of course we'll have to see".

How do you see the future of the Club I asked? "Like most of these types of clubs we're seeing less and less younger members coming through. We need people to join us to keep the interest high and varied. The annual membership fee is £25 to cover admin and other costs and it's a great way of keeping active and involved with something on a regular basis. Everyone works hard to keep things going but having more on board would really help".


General restrictions on movements does continue to have had a positive impact on crime but there are opportunist thieves taking advantage of the situation as they arrive.






