Winds Point

Did you know that 'Winds Point' road is named after the house that once stood there?

The house shown in this photograph is Winds Point which was built on Worcester Road for a local solicitor, Wickham King who, with his wife Beatrice Mary, moved into it in 1906. It was demolished in 1964 and new houses were built on the site.

Wickham King was also an amateur geologist, climber and treasurer of the Appeal Committee which raised funds to pay for the building of St. Saviour's Church in West Hagley.

Hagley Library

The County Council has worked closely with local library volunteers throughout the phased re-opening of libraries and it is thanks to their help and support that Hagley has reopened. Library customers at all re-opened libraries will be able to:

- browse shelves and borrow books using self-service kiosks
- return books
- pre-book public computers
- pre-book a desk in the library for study and/ or wi-fi access

Library staff will also be on hand to answer queries and provide information.

Social distancing and hygiene measures will be in place in all libraries for everyone's safety. The number of customers allowed into the library at any one time will be managed; browsing time will be limited to 20 minutes and computers and desks will be cleaned thoroughly after each use. All library visitors are required to wear face coverings

Poppy Appeal 2020

2020 has been a very difficult year for all of us, and for charities in particular, the opportunities for fundraising have been extremely limited, and The Royal British Legion's Poppy Appeal was significantly affected as our prime fundraising is concentrated around just two weeks in late October and Early November. Up until September, we were working on the assumption that we could do nothing in Blakedown and Hagley as the only sources of poppies were planned to be online and via the major supermarkets.

We were then advised that we could take part in a very restricted appeal. Our decision was based on the fact that our Pop-Up Poppy Stall raised over a third of our district total in 2019, that this was the one thing that we could do. I was introduced to the world of Risk Assessments and PPE, which was certainly not my expectation when becoming a District Poppy Appeal Organiser! Our risk assessment determined that we would close the stall if we moved to Tier 2 for the protection of our collectors and members of the public.

With the kind permission of Lex Allen Grove, we set up our gazebo on the decking outside their premises in Worcester Road, and I must pay tribute to the team of collectors helping us. With the need to provide PPE, we had to severely limit the number of collectors, which meant that each one had to man the stand for quite a few two-hour slots.

Bad weather at the end of the first week meant that our gazebo tried to escape from its location, and we decided to take it down on the Saturday at the end of our first week. With the announcement of the lockdown, and the high infection rates in Hagley at that time, we felt that it was responsible not to open up again for the second week. We are sorry if anyone missed out, but protection had to be our first priority.

Now for the good news. Thanks to the generosity of people in Hagley, our village total (so far) amounts to £5,191 – well over half our total for 2019 when we had poppy tins in most of the shops and pubs around the village, and of course twice the time



collecting, and a much wider range of merchandise. Thank you, everyone.

This was a first year of having available a contactless donation terminal enabling people to donate through their phones or cards, particularly now that we all carry much less cash than we used to. This provided about a quarter of the funds that we raised on the Poppy Stall, and has been booked again for next year!

I must give a particular mention to Katherine's Sourdough who donated some very special Remembrance Focaccia Loaves, with all proceeds going to the appeal, Coopers Troopers Bootcamp and Hagley Primary School for significant collections, and Jacqui Thompson for collecting money around her home to purchase a wreath for her part of Hagley to lay at the War Memorial on Remembrance Sunday. Now there's a challenge for every road in Hagley for 2021! There were many more demonstrations of your generosity.

Next Year is The Royal British Legion's 100th birthday, and we hope to make an additional appearance in the Summer, CoVid permitting. Across the UK, we are still spending about £2 million per week on welfare for our veterans and their families, and mental health and financial issues remain a very important part of our case list. To paraphrase a well-known film, "we will be back".

Accurx Online: The Wyre Forest Health Partnership wants to make getting in touch with Hagley surgery as easy as possible and have introduced a new service to contact us online to replace 'Ask My GP'. As of Monday 16th November, you can contact us about a medical, administrative or prescription issue through the link on our website; you will need to answer a few short questions and we will then get back to you. The new platform doesn't require you to have any additional passwords and can be accessed throughout the day allowing many queries to be resolved quickly and efficiently. It's very easy to use. For more information, or the link to use this fantastic service visit our surgery website.

Appointments: We are continuing to operate a telephone appointment system at the surgery and have continued to find that this is well received. For those patients who need to, we are still carrying out face to face appointments at the surgery and anyone that needs to come in and see the Doctor, Nurse or Physician's associate will be offered this option if it is clinically indicated. This will be explained and a time mutually agreed between the patient and the clinician during the initial telephone call.

All appointments (including telephone slots and selected nurse appointments for smears or blood tests) continue to be available to book online where you have online access to your medical record. It is really easy to do – to sign up if you haven't already please speak to reception via telephone or via our online portal on the website. You can access appointment booking or order repeat prescriptions at anytime from anywhere so it really is worthwhile signing up.

Staffing changes: We welcomed our Physician's Associate Elizabeth to our team in November 2020 and she has now settled in well and is seeing and speaking to patients over the telephone. If you are unfamiliar with this new role, a Physician Associate is a clinician that supports the work of doctors by diagnosing and managing patients with a variety of new and long-standing illnesses. We are pleased to have Elizabeth on board and she is proving to be a great addition to our surgery team.

However effective the new anti-covid vaccines, and however expertly they are dispensed for general use, it will take months stretching to a year or two before previously normal Club activities can be resumed. The changes brought about by covid, not least in individual attitudes to risk, uncertainty and inconvenience, make it difficult to visualise how the Club of the future could operate. Even without covid the Club was facing an uphill battle against demographics and cultural change, e.g. acceptance of Zoom.

Informal soundings of its membership show no willingness for the Club to wither away. It is too long-established as a factor for good in the social life of Hagley and its surroundings. Besides, the difficulties it faces in keeping the Club alive during months of dormancy are faced by a number of other local groups, and some of them may have important things to tell us about adapting to the menace of covid.

The consensus seems to be that while covid is being stamped out the Club should remain dormant but in contact with its members. A dormant Club has more potential than one that has been shut down, for instance in resuscitating the lecture programme that was abandoned when covid first appeared. A membership drive will be essential, to enlarge a core group of active members. The AGM originally scheduled for February 2021 will be deferred till later in the year and will probably have a new format. Meanwhile documents appropriate to the AGM will go out by post. **Chris Morrissey**


Instead we held our first Virtual meeting by Zoom, on Friday 13th November with 11 entries and about 15 participants; it was very successful and we will do it again.

We wish you and your families the very best of the Christmas and New Year period and a very Happy 2021.




Hagley Primary School PTA

Interview

Ten minutes in the company of ... Sue Dean, Hagley Theatre Group

I began by asking Sue to give some background to the Group. "What is now Hagley Theatre Group was started in 1946 by Mr J Adams who wanted to support the Girls Brigade by setting up a play. From these early days when the group was called 'Let's do a play' 'Hagley Theatre Group' was born. It originally used the old church hall which was on the corner of Church Street moving to the new Community Centre in the playing fields in 1969 where it has performed ever since."

Sue went on to explain her role and the importance of the group of volunteers. "I joined the group in 1965 and I'm the current President whilst the group is run by Beth Smith who along with all the volunteers make up a fantastic and very dynamic team. The group make their own costumes, scenery and props with all being self-funded through ticket sales and fund raising."

I asked about the how the youth section was formed. "From the early roots in 1990 a youth section was created and since then 30 musicals have been performed in front of capacity audiences in the community centre hall. This year will be the first year that a performance could not gone ahead."

"The main age group is between 12 to 18. We have a good waiting list, and we can keep our numbers high. We are generally low on boys joining the group, but everyone is very enthusiastic, and everyone gets very involved in the group." added Sue.

What is the aim of the group? "The ethos of the group is 'to promote confidence and teamwork and provide an accepting space, encouraging children to be creative and enthusiastic'." Sue made the very important point that this is massively important for mental health and wellbeing. "It gives young people fantastic life skills and confidence and is something they remember for the rest of their lives."

The group also takes children on residential trips which helps with team spirit and bonding. "There are some fantastic experiences when you see quiet shy children coming in, who might think they cannot sing or could not take leading roles develop into mature and confident adults. We all love it, and everyone gets on with each other. We hope the group carriers on, and the young continue to take the lead and get involved" enthused Sue.

"We do all our own fund raising and we are now raising money for the community centre refurbishment as we need extra storage space at the centre. We hope that this time next year we'll be preparing for the return of the theatre group as soon as we can."





Hagley String Orchestra

Italy is known as the birthplace of modern opera following Monteverdi's works from 1607. Italy is also where today's string instruments were developed in the northern town of Cremona, which lies about 83 km SE of Milan. Cremona has a history in making lutes as far back as 13th century and subsequently viols. Monteverdi, born in Cremona in 1567, was an experienced violinist, and used advanced string techniques in his operas.

The most famous of violin makers are the Stradivari family, but they were taught by the earlier Amatis. Lorenzo de' Medici ordered one of the first violins from Andrea Amati in 1555 'made of the highest quality materials like that of a lute, but simple to play' (!) Later, Catherine de' Medici ordered from Amati a complete orchestra of 38 string instruments. Paganini (1782-1840) played on a 1600 Amati as well as Strads, made from, he said, 'the wood of trees on which nightingales sang'.

21-year-old Sheku Kanneh-Mason is fortunate to play on an Amati cello c. 1610, kindly loaned from a private collection. It's no wonder then that in baroque Italy there were many superb violinist/composers such as Corelli, Vivaldi and Tartini, whose ebullient music we love to play. Jeremy Patterson - Conductor
