

The Demolition of Mission Hall

This photograph shows the beginning of the demolition of the Mission Hall on the corner of Church Street and Worcester Road. Health and safety requirements have changed considerably since 1972!

Mission Hall was designed by Tom Grazebrook (son of JP Grazebrook of The Court, Hagley) and opened on 18th December 1882. After St. Saviour's church was opened in 1908 it was no longer needed as a church and was used as a Parish of Boom. In the 1930s it was also a branch of

Lloyd's bank on three days per week. When St Saviour's Church Hall was opened, Mission Hall was demolished. Next time you go shopping see if you can spot what stands on that corner today?

The beautiful Witley Court Another delightful painting by local artist Mike Spencer

Witley Court estate was named after the town of Great Witley and sits in 40-acres of land four miles northwest of Worcestershire and just short of an hour outside Birmingham.

It was one of Europe's most lavish Victorian estates with an iconic portico and timeless fountain being hallmarks of this treasure. For centuries and having nearly one hundred staff, it served as a residence for British Lords who often entertained royalty.


In 1937 a devastating fire ravaged the building, and finding it too costly to rebuild the owners to abandoned it. Decades later the derelict building was rescued and preserved leaving it as the grandest Victorian manor in an arrested state of decay.

QUITE A SCENE NOT TO BE MISSED!

Known as the Perseus and Andromeda fountain, it depicts a well-known scene from Greek mythology whereby Perseus rescues Andromeda from a sea monster on the back of a winged horse. It has been fully restored with 120 jets hidden among the shells, sea nymphs and dolphins and comes to life every day on the hour every hour from 11am til 4pm from April to the end of October.

With its hauntingly wonderful ruins, spectacular gardens and woodlands walks, Witley Court as Mike says "is a most beautiful place to visit and not too far from Hagley"



Interview

Ten minutes in the company of Rachel Coton – Ranger Leader and Walton District Leader, Hagley Guides, Brownies and Rainbows

Rachel became Ranger Leader in 2016 growing the original number from 2 to the current 20 Rangers. The unit was originally started way back before the 1970s but subsequently closed in the mid-1990s.

When Rachel was first approached to restart the unit there were 2 girls interested in joining. This soon rose to its current level of 20, twice the average. Rachel is used to working with teenagers and was an experienced Head of 6th Form

Rachel said "the response has been fantastic, when the girls finish Guides at 14, they're very keen to carry on and move into the Ranger unit, staying right up until just before their 19th birthday when a lot then become Young Leaders. The success is due to there being two strong Guide groups and so when the girls get to the end they want to carry on and do something else."

I asked what attracts so many to want to join the Hagley set? "There's a fantastic sense of pride as well as camaraderie, helping and supporting each other and in times when there are increasing pressures on teenagers the unit helps support mental health wellbeing, there is a strong bond which helps build strong social strengths."

"During Lockdown, the unit met via Zoom. It gave the girls something to look forward to when there was nothing else, we meet every week and became very creative throughout the year. Even the GCSEs were cancelled so it gave everyone the opportunity to keep in touch.

Normally, the unit do some very engaging tasks such as 'bake off competitions' star bakers, walks, activities, as well as treasure hunt competitions. The unit carryout litter picks around Hagley. Rachel added "To have Brownies litter picks around the village is fantastic to see. They're not only helping to keep Hagley tidy they're sending out

a strong message that is saying we won't drop litter and we don't want others to drop it either. Hopefully when litter bugs see the effort these young people are putting in it might make them think twice".



In Rachel's role as Ranger District Leader, she's heavily involved in helping young girls get on their feet and giving them self-esteem. "The Rangers give them a fantastic opportunity to bond as a team and it certainly gives them some life skills".

One of the most memorable events the Rangers take part in is the London 'Monopoly run'. This is where we meet at Paddington Station, underneath the clock at 9:00 am on a given Saturday in the summer. The task is based on an App which has cryptic clues to where the teams must go to and answer questions. This means that up to 5000 guides are running across London, using the tube and public transport all day long. The girls are really looking forward to 2022 when it is hoped that the competition is restarted

A few gardening hints from John Oakes, one of our former Chairmen.

The summer solstice bringing the longest day, Wimbledon and strawberries, it has got to be June. The scent of roses and honeysuckle in the air, a hint of cloves from the pinks or dianthus, May and June are the most perfumed of months. If you are a hay fever sufferer you have our commiserations, for there is an abundant amount of pollen in the air. Before we start enjoying ourselves there is some work to be done. All the bedding plants can be put out with little fear of frost. Plant dahlias for bright colour in August and September. You can almost sit back and relax and hopefully invite a few friends round to admire your handy work. Alas the lawn needs cutting

regularly, some, twice a week, to keep that golf course look. The hanging baskets can be filled with petunias, begonias, fuchsias or plants of your choice.

Plant out tomato plants 45cm apart in well prepared ground or in grow bags or 35cm dia. pots. Put in stout stakes for support. Pinch out all the side shoots except bush types, and limit height to four trusses of fruit. They need lots and lots of water. You will never ever taste a better tomato, believe me.







The continued Covid-19 restrictions meant that this year's Annual Parish Meeting was held virtually via Zoom. The Council submitted written reports from the Lead Councillors on the year ended 31st March 2021. It is hoped that next year's meeting will once again be held in public with the public in attendance.

Copies of the Lead Councillor reports have been made available on Hagley Parish Council's website and will form part of the minutes of the meeting.

It is great news to report that the Dial-a-ride bus has restarted after being suspended following the lockdown 3 at the start of the year. The bus will follow 'Covid safe' rules and will make trips to Stourbridge, Kidderminster, and Longbridge. I am very keen that this service is taken up by many more users as it is an excellent way of keeping mobile and helping people get out and about. The destinations also include

The playing fields and Pavilion are nearing completion. The Pavilion external works are underway whilst the internal works are due for its final safety inspection. The field is now being cut regularly, along with final seeding a general maintenance works. As a reminder STW is responsible for returning the field to pre-drainage works and as such is making sure that the field will meet that standard before removing the fencing.


