Fanny Davis


This photograph shows Fanny Davis with her parents, unfortunately the photograph is undated, but the clothing they wear could give some clues. Fanny's high neckline, the pleats on the skirts and the neat, unfussy hairstyles indicate a fashionable style for the 1880s.

Fanny became headmistress at the old Infant School in Bromsgrove Road, Hagley and continued in that post for 15 years.

She married William Griffiths Wooldridge, the Hagley blacksmith, in 1877. The 1891 census shows her employed as a schoolmistress aged 30 and the 1901 census shows her age as 40 with no occupation. This was because she had retired at age 38 in 1899 because of ill health. Upon retirement Fanny was presented with a timepiece, a purse of gold and a water colour painting of Hagley Views by Lady Cobham, the rector William Cobham Gibbs, Mrs Gibbs, Miss Ellen Lucy Grazebrook and Miss Williams.

William and Fanny had a son Gilbert who was born in 1891. Gilbert later married Doris and she kindly donated this photograph of her mother-in-law and grandparents-in-law.



Interview

Ten minutes in the company of Jo Gregory - LifeCentral Church

Welcome to this month's article, this is the first of a series of intended interviews with the three Hagley Churches. I've chosen to interview representatives from the churches as they play an important part in our community. I begin with Jo Gregory Location Paster for Hagley and started by asking her to describe the church and its activities.

Jo began by explaining her role in the church. "I'm responsible for looking after the Hagley Congregation and Hagley core Leaders, organising the Services, speakers and events.

The main church hub is in Halesowen with branches here, Rowley and Durres Albania. We first established our base here in 2017 with services being held at Haybridge High School and followed a strategy of growth aimed at developing multiple sites and increasing congregations and volunteers."

"We operate with a core team of leaders and a team of community volunteers. We're keen to establish a community within a community. We love Hagley; it has a great community to be a part of and we aim to 'Help People to Find and Follow Jesus'" Jo added.

From supporting the Hagley Christmas event I'm very aware of the role Churches play in the wider community that people aren't aware of. I asked Jo to highlight a few of the volunteer work that they do.


"We do a lot, including litter picks, looking after the Jubilee Garden and have painted the benches in the playing fields. During the Covid lockdowns we supported vulnerable and elderly residents by fetching prescriptions, helped with shopping and general essential errands. These relationships have continued outside lockdown, and we run a 'befriending service' where we keep in touch with our friends."

I asked what regular embedded services LifeCentral now provide. "Just before Lockdown we began to hold 'multigeneration' Tea Dances whereby invite all age groups aimed at bringing together people of all ages. We hope to start that again ASAP. We also run 'Little Treasures - Parent and Toddler groups' followed by a drop-in 'Communi-Tea' session where all are welcome to meet and chat. We also donate a Santa and Elves to the event and support with its organising and last year's 'Virtually the same' Christmas video. We've adopted the community Hall and run as many of our activities as possible from there. "

I asked how Jo would describe the services. "They're a relaxed approach but they're equally a lively and vibrant family service and are held in the community centre, Sunday's starting at 10:00 am. We don't duck any topics or any everyday life issues and hold teaching topics as we want to help people in their everyday lives. Pre-Covid we had congregations of between 80-90 so we don't know if we'll return to those numbers later this summer or it might take time again to get people's confidence back to join large gatherings. We've been holding services online and so have reached thousands of people virtually."





Hagley Neighbourhood Watch

Reported crimes of all types in and around Hagley have thankfully remained low. It's probably worth reminding everyone of despite this to continue to take the simple steps to help ensure that we don't become another crime statistic.

Remember to keep valuables either locked away or out of sight in vehicles, lock sheds and remote buildings, let friends and neighbours know if you're going away, cancel news papers and milk, leave a couple of lights on after dark if you're going out, don't allow strangers or uninvited visitor into your property without your prior knowledge, don't buy goods or services on the doorstep and keep passwords and personal information private and out of sight.



I continue to hope that this Neighbourhood watch is helpful and keeps you informed of what is happening in Hagley and measures you can take to keep you, your family, and your property safe.

APPOINTMENTS: As restrictions releasing we wanted to update our patients on how our appointment system will operate as we move forward. As always, the team at Hagley Surgery are here to support you and your health conditions and can be accessed via telephone, online or by popping into the surgery. Face coverings are still being promoted in the surgery environment wherever possible. We will be continuing to operate an 'on the day' telephone appointment system at the surgery as we have continued to find that this is well received and had positive feedback. For those patients where the Doctor feels an examination is needed, they will be invited to the surgery to see the Doctor, Nurse or healthcare professional in a face to face appointment. This will be explained and a time mutually agreed between the patient and the clinician during the initial telephone call.

All appointments (including telephone slots and selected nurse appointments for smears or blood tests) continue to be available to book online where you have online access to your medical record. It is really easy to do – to sign up if you haven't already please

speak to reception via telephone or via our online portal on the website. You can access appointment booking or order repeat prescriptions at anytime from anywhere so it really is worthwhile signing up.

ACCURX ONLINE: Did you know we have a webform that can be accessed via our website that you can use if you need to ask the surgery a question? By filling in the web form, you can use this service to avoid waiting on the phone. This can be used to check your test results, ask the admin or clinical team a question, order any medical notes, sick notes or reports or book nonurgent telephone calls with the team. This can be done at any time of the day or night and will be looked at by one of the team within 24hours. We do ask that patients take a look and use this system wherever possible but PLEASE NOTE THIS IS NOT FOR URGENT CLINICAL ENQUIRIES.

Hagley String Orchestra

String music from the Baroque era is the staple diet for our string repertoire. This period of music lasted about 150 years dating from about 1600 to the deaths of JS Bach (1750) and Handel (1759). Why is Baroque string music so exhilarating?

We need to go back to the 15th century Renaissance era when instruments called viols were developed. Viols had flat backs and fingerboard frets, rather like guitars, were bowed underhand, and all the instruments from treble to bass were held upright, the smaller ones perched on the knee. Across Europe viols varied, for example some having 4 strings and others 6. As they became popular, Consorts of Viols became part of courtly music; in 1540 they are mentioned in the King's Musick.

The violin family of instruments developed separately, and they are not related to viols. They began in Italy around 1550 and were used mainly to accompany dancing. As we know, the great luthiers such as Amati and Stradivari lived in Cremona, and their superb instruments expanded the techniques, flexibility and rich sound qualities, thus

developing how composers wrote for strings. For some time viol music and violin music continued side by side; Henry Purcell (1659-95) composing either for Viol Consorts or String Orchestras.

The violin family offered far more expression, becoming increasingly popular and saw the demise of viols, which today have been resurrected by specialist performers.


