Hagley Historical and Field Society Hagley Station in 1964

This view of Hagley station was taken in 1964. Hagley station first appeared in timetables in 1862 as part of the Oxford, Worcester and Wolverhampton railway, it was a rough and ready structure with platforms built of old sleepers.


The inhabitants of Hagley fought the GWR (Great Western Railway) from 1875 until 1884 to get improved transport facilities and the rebuilt station and its approach road (Station Drive) were opened later that year, jointly funded by both parties.

The large building on the right is a typical GWR late 19th century structure but the wooden building on the same platform

is much older. The building on the other platform has now gone, but it survived (without its canopy) until the 1980s. Notice the very tall signal by the left of the bridge, it was positioned high was so that it could be seen over both bridges.

The footbridge to the rear of the photograph was a standard feature of the 1880s, but very few survive. It was Grade II listed by Historic England in 2000 and restored to its original condition in 2012 at a cost of £50,000. It is also familiar to model railway enthusiasts after being made into model by Hornby for its train sets.

A Message From Jacob

Hello all - I'm Jacob Tumelty. I live in Hagley and work at Breach House Care Home in Belbroughton. My colleague Shannon Byrne has organised a Sky-dive fundraiser which my fellow staff members and I will be taking part in. By doing so we aim to raise awareness and aid research for a charity which is very close to our hearts.

Alzheimer's disease is an irreversible, progressive brain disorder that slowly destroys memory, thinking skills and eventually the ability to carry out the simplest of tasks. 1 in 6 people over the age of 80 have dementia. 70% of people in care homes have dementia or severe memory problems. There are over 42,000 people under 65 with dementia in the UK. At the current rate of prevalence there will be over 1.5 million people with this illness in the UK by the year 2040.

Within our roles as carers we see people affected by Alzheimer's and dementia on a daily basis. We deal with the different effects it has on each individual, the impact it has on their daily lives and also their family. Many people who suffer have a lot of anxiety are scared, confused, frustrated, and tormented. So nine members of our care staff will take a 10,000ft leap of faith out of a plane later on in the year to raise funds for the Alzheimer's Society. We hope that our efforts will help with research to improve the daily lives of people who suffer with this disease. And hopefully one day a cure can be found.

Step Back In Time.....to 1865

Hagley Court 1865

Hagley Court was located at the junction of Kidderminster Road and Stourbridge Road, opposite what is now Market Way. It was originally called Hagley Cottage; ironmaster John Philips Grazebrook bought it, renamed it and extended it to suit his growing family. The photo of the house was taken in 1865. The photo of Mrs Grazebrook in her carriage outside Hagley Court must be later as the walls then show significant foliage cover. The building later became a nursing home and subsequently Hagley Court Hotel, then Hagley Country Club before it was demolished in the 1960s.

Interview

Ten minutes in the company of Reverend David Tennant - Hagley Free Church

Thank you for joining me in my chat with the Reverend David Tennant who coincidently is retiring after more than 25 years here in Hagley and 56 years as a minister starting in Melksham then Hall Green B'ham, then locum work, before serving the Hagley Free Church and others.

Born in Coventry with a Grammar school education leaving at 16 and training in management accountancy David later went to Bristol Baptist College where upon graduating took a full-time ministry in Melksham for 5 years before moving to Hall Green, B'ham a large suburban church. "I was very happy there but moved to teach 'Church Education' in the Selly Oak Colleges. I did this full time for 20 years, and along with preaching on Sunday's I served on church councils and did a lot of committee work which I enjoyed enormously" added David. During this period David travelled overseas as well supporting overseas students in the UK.

"In the early 80's I came to Hagley Free church on some Sundays for special occasions, funerals, and weddings, before finally taking a part time minister role here".

I asked him how he became a minister and how his faith developed as a young man.

David replied "It was unusual because my parents were not regular church goers but from an early age, I had strong convictions that this is what I should do, I thought carefully about the calling at first but have no regrets whatsoever and it has been very important to me. Making the decision brought peace and contentment".

"I since learnt that I did have a great great grandfather who was an untrained preacher who I did not know until recently. The world has certainly changed since I first became a minister and increasingly believe that churches should come together. Over the years I have had great support from Rev Newton and more recently have met with Lifecentral. Hopefully this is something for the future.

I asked how congregations have changed. "Congregations in the Free Church are not growing with a very small number of families, but the church reaches into community with 'Hand of Friendship', Guides and Brownies, orchestra and choir groups, and 'Parent and Toddlers' and other activities. Whilst the services have seen a drop in attendance the commitment and faith of the regulars remain strong. The hall is very popular and used widely and so the Free Church remains a very important part of the community."

The Church and Hall were built 1905 and were because of the growth of the village with the local rail connections. It is a united church replacing the Methodist Chapel in Chapel Street.

I would like to extend my thanks and congratulations to David on his retirement and hope David will enjoy his well-deserved rest and have more time to enjoy his love of steam engines and railways.



Bromsgrove District Council

At the time of writing the continued rise in Covid infections has limited Bromsgrove Council to restrict meetings in person to Full Council and a few specific meetings such as planning.

The Council will continue to follow Government guidance as regards working practices and returning to a greater degree of normality. There was an issue in August with Council waste staff being 'pinged' and therefore had to follow government guidance and isolate. This led to slight delays in collecting a few bins across Hagley.

I'm disappointed that there were NO bids put forward by any Hagley groups from this year's New Homes Bonus. In the past Hagley has benefited from receiving very important inward investment to help groups and societies.

There were several flooding issues reported in Hagley over the summer following heavy rainfall resulting in storm water overloading the drainage system in places. There have been a series of investigations particularly along the Worcester Rd (B4187). My thanks go to County Councillor May and the Highways team for their help in resolve these long running issues. At the time of writing a report on the 2019 Chestnut Drive culvert flooding is still awaited. This is due later this summer.

There is pressure on the green belt; it is important to have your say on what will have an impact on where we live. I would urge you to register to the Black Country Development plan consultation as greenbelt on the Stourbridge border (Worcester Rd) is already identified as a possible development site.

APPOINTMENTS: As restrictions are releasing we wanted to update our patients on how our appointment system will operate as we move forward. The team at Hagley Surgery are here to support you and your health conditions and can be accessed via telephone, online or by popping into the surgery. Face coverings are still being promoted in the surgery environment wherever possible. We will be continuing to operate an 'on the day' telephone appointment system at the surgery as we have continued to find that this is well received and had positive feedback. For those patients where the Doctor feels an examination is needed, they will be invited to the surgery to see the Doctor, Nurse or healthcare professional in a face to face appointment. This will be explained and a time mutually agreed between the patient and the clinician during the initial telephone call.

All appointments (including telephone slots and selected nurse appointments for smears or blood tests) continue to be available to book online where you have online access to your medical record. It is really easy to do – to sign up if you haven't already please speak to reception via telephone or via our online portal on the website. You can access appointment booking or order repeat prescriptions at anytime from anywhere so it really is worthwhile signing up.
