HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

FREE CHILDREN'S ENTERTAINMENT IN 1965

This advertisement must have thrilled parents in Hagley when they saw it in October 1965. The poster was found in Martin Lister's carefully catalogued collection of press cuttings and memorabilia of Hagley from the early 1960s. Martin was one of the founder members of Hagley Historical and Field Society.

At that time the village hall (called the Parish Room) was in the building that used to stand on the corner of Church Street and Worcester Road. It became redundant after St Saviour's church hall was opened which led to it being demolished in 1972; it was then replaced by shops.

Many of our older residents will remember the Brooke Bond chimps from their own childhood; first appearing on Christmas Day in 1956, having been inspired by chimpanzees' tea parties at London Zoo. The chimp adverts were discontinued in 2002, when the use of the animals was no longer considered acceptable.

Shelsey Walsh in Worcestershire was mentioned in the Doomsday book as a quiet clearing on a wooded slope, however, since 1905 motor sports enthusiasts have associated the village with the roar of engines. As the oldest motorsport venue in the world, come and find out more about the village and the Shelsey Walsh Speed Hill Climb, which still runs on the original course and is older than Indianapolis, Le Mans or Monza.



INTERVIEW

Ten minutes in the company of Jonathan Plant - Royal British Legion

Born and raised in Station Road where the family lived for 98 years only leaving to move the short distance with Judy and the family to the top of Hagley where they have lived since 2003.

Jonathan dedicates much of his spare time since 2016 to being the RBL Treasurer along with helping a small team to run the Poppy Appeal and the Remembrance Services. The RBL has always had a strong presence in Hagley since the branch was formed in 1929 when at the time, and for many years after, every man had to do national service. The Legion was established to provide welfare and support to service men and woman and their families through comradeship. The original branch was formed in Blakedown and there is still a Plaque commemorating the branch hanging in the 'Old House at Home' public house.

In Jonathan's younger years he ran a Short Tennis Group in Hagley, later volunteering as an umpire, including five years as line umpire at Wimbledon. His claim to fame as a chair umpire was a match involving Caroline Wozniaki who went on to become World Number 1 – admittedly she was only 12 at the time! Jonathan's son has also officiated at Wimbledon since 2004 including the Men's Semi Finals on three occasions. His other son runs the falconry centre at Webbs in Hagley, and his daughter is Commercial Manager at Three Roses Homes at Clent, where Jonathan is Chairman of Trustees.

As a working man Jon was a financial advisor and specialist in military finances and on one occasion lectured Prince Harry on financial awareness when he was a serving helicopter pilot.

Like most of RBL Supporters, he did not serve in the forces, but has experience in working with the forces. "These guys have been trained not to be emotional and trained in warfare and when they leave find civilian life difficult. The RBL run six residential care homes and actively support ex-service personnel. An example was where the Legion supported one serviceman living on his own to find a flat. He was helped with furnishings and to apply for jobs. Beneficiaries say that the most important aspect of our work is having someone to listen to their problems and care enough to make things better."

I asked Jon how the modern world was reacting to the RBL. "Covid has removed RBL and most other charities from the front page, and we have had to discourage those in the village from taking a full part in Remembrance. However the success of the Poppy Appeal with £10,735 raised in Blakedown and Hagley this year, and the support for our 100th Anniversary celebrations across the country gives me full confidence for the future"

Having worked with Jon I know how stretched the RBL can be and so I asked him how reliant they are on volunteers. "We're extremely reliant on people giving up lots of their spare time. The hours that we put in to raise money and support exmilitary personnel and their families are tremendous. It would be a great loss to Hagley if this branch was to close, and we really need the next generation to come forward" concluded Jon.

HAGLEY STRING ORCHESTRA

Over the past weeks, we've been working at some unfamiliar music – Concertino Pastorale for String Orchestra by John Ireland. It was composed in 1939 when Ireland was 60, and it's dedicated to Boyd Neel who had a famous string group at that time.

John Ireland (1879-1962) was born near Altringham, Cheshire, to Scottish parents. When he was 14, he began piano and organ lessons at the Royal College of Music, London, but in that year his mother died, and only a year later his father also. These tragedies must have affected him greatly, possibly throughout his life. When at the RCM he became influenced by the music of Debussy, Ravel, Stravinsky and Bartok, and his music is expressive and impressionistic. As the organist at several London churches, he wrote many hymns and anthems, wellknown ones including the hymn 'My Song is Love Unknown' and the anthem 'Greater love hath no man'. Piano music and songs were also an important part of his output.

Concertino Pastorale is in three movements – a dramatic, lyrical Eclogue, a most poignant Threnody, and finally an exuberant (and technically demanding!) Toccata. It is exciting

to discover and learn to appreciate new music, and we now realise what a wonderful and 'heart-on-sleeve' work this is.



BROMSGROVE DISTRICT COUNCIL

We're currently involved with play areas and tree issues on Wychbury Lawns and Fields. On Wychbury Lawns the play area suffers from flooding making safe play impossible. It effectively means that the site has not complied with the planning requirements until the site management company install drainage.

The play area on Wychbury Fields has been paused as the site has proved to be unsafe and not fit for purpose. The location of this is under discussions between the developer and Bromsgrove's Planning Department.

A survey of trees on Wychbury sites has confirmed that there are 57 missing or dead trees against the developer's commitment to replace trees at a higher ratio compared to trees that were removed from the site upon its clearance.

There have been several trees blown down or have died over the last 2 or 3 years. These trees are on WCC grass verges. I'm continuing to press that these are replaced and where trees have been missing for some time for new trees to be planted.

The district council's Waste and Environmental Teams have been excellent during the pandemic and have coped well with reduced manpower. Our Place Team continue to respond quickly to our requests i.e., roads and pavements need leaves to be removed, before they cause the drains to get blocked. I asked for the path and gully sweepers to be deployed in the worst affected areas. I'm so pleased that within a few days the clear-up had begun.


