many large houses were commandeered for use, and Lightwoods Park in Bearwood, Smethwick was no exception. During the conflict, more than 1,300 soldiers recuperated at the Park, come along and find out some of their stories.

At the end of the 17th century Poland was the largest state in Europe but within a hundred years it had been partitioned by its powerful neighbours and partly absorbed into the Russian empire. The Poles reacted to Russia's brutal suppression of their uprising in 1830 by developing a strong cultural identity in which artists played a key role. Writer, lecturer and translator, Rosamund Bartlett will show how Frederic Chopin and his revolutionary polonaises and mazurkas came to be regarded as an indispensable

symbol of the Polish nation both during his lifetime and in the years before Poland regained its independence in 1918.

HAGLEY STRING ORCHESTRA

I don't think that HSO has played Gershwin before, certainly not with me. An arrangement of his 'Lullaby' (composed 1919 as a harmony exercise) has been a welcome contrast to our other music this Spring Term.

George Gershwin (1898-1937) was born in Brooklyn, New York, to Ukrainian-Jewish parents, and he had an elder brother Ira as well as a younger brother and sister. All musical and artistic, they frequently visited the local Yiddish theatres, Gershwin sometimes acting on stage. Ira was given a piano which he didn't enjoy, but Gershwin aged about 10 found he had a great talent. He left school aged 15 to work on Tin Pan Alley, arranging hundreds of songs and recording them. In 1919 his first big hit was 'Swanee' being sung by Al Jolson, this being followed by 'Rhapsody in Blue' in 1924.

During the '20s, he decided he needed composition lessons and went to Paris asking Ravel for lessons, to which Ravel replied Why become a second-rate Ravel when you're already a first-rate Gershwin." It was here he wrote 'American in Paris', and he became influenced by the music of Debussy and Stravinsky amongst others.

By 1937 he was the most famous US composer. In the February he was the soloist in his Piano Concerto when he had blackouts, and it was discovered he had a brain tumour. The leading surgeon was on holiday on a boat, and the White House instructed for him to be collected and flown to the hospital. The tumour was removed, but Gershwin died on 11 July aged only 38. His Memorial Concert at the Hollywood Bowl was conducted by the great Otto Klemperer.

A MESSAGE FROM CLENT HILLS VETS: Sarah, our Deputy Head Nurse at Hagley recently organised a collection of dog and cat food, blankets, and treats to support the Ukraine crisis. To say the donations were overwhelming is an understatement. THANK YOU to everyone who has donated so far! Sarah delivered the items to a lady in Worcester, and a lorry will be collecting these donations and taking them to Ukraine. There will more lorries and several collection dates coming up, so if you have anything you wish to donate, we are still happy to receive these at Clent Hills Vets in Hagley.



WORCESTERSHIRE COMMUNITIES RESPONSE FOR UKRAINE:

A number of local community groups are taking action so please be careful about what you donate and avoid sending inexperienced volunteers in cars and vans.

If community groups want to gather goods to send out to Ukraine or its borders please ensure they get their goods to Attwell Park Farm, Seafield Lane, B98 9DB, just north of Redditch off the A435. They are open 9am to 5pm for drop offs, 7 days a week. https:// attwellfarmpark.co.uk/plan-your.../howto-get-here. Goods should be in pallet format where possible or boxed in a way so they can be quickly loaded on to pallets. Please only supply essential goods from the lists (check online for updates on what's needed):

- Cosmetics and toiletries: shower gel, shampoo, soap, toothbrushes/toothpaste, barrier creams, sanitary napkins, nappies for children (sizes 3-4-5), washing liquids for children, dishwashing liquids, etc.

- Dressings: sterile gauze, sterile compresses, knitted bands, bandages, elastic bandages, ampoules of potassium salt, disinfectants, gloves, disposable sterile drape dressings, tourniquets, cello, sterile tweezers, cotton wool dressing, scissors, plasters.
- Blankets/sleeping bags. Sweets for children Bought products need to be in the purchased sealed, carton. The intention is that local groups across Worcestershire will collect goods from the public and then drop them off to Attwell Farm - please don't send people directly. Oakland International are providing the lorries, drivers and coordination at a UK level response - up to 50 transports from 10 hubs countrywide taking goods to the border areas and into Ukraine if they can get through.



Thank you to all residents who attended the Annual Parish Meeting last month. It was a good event, and your input was valuable. Copies of the reports can be found on our website.

You may have noticed that tree work has started around the playing field. As part of our strategy for replacing the diseased horse chestnuts, there will be maintenance of existing trees and planting of new trees including 13 sweet chestnuts (that are less susceptible to disease than horse chestnuts) and three limes. We do plan to keep some horse chestnuts as generations of our locals have fond memories of conker collecting over the years. Tree-management works will continue as part of our five- year plan. We will also be planting a tree to commemorate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee.

We will be making improvements to the library and work will be carried out over the coming months. Councillor Jim Austin has been working with the team at the library to find out what they need, and we'll keep you posted via our website as it all takes place. The investment required for this work is coming from the Welcome Back Fund' from Bromsgrove District Council and funding from the precept.

HAGLEY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Hagley Neighbourhood Plan team is beginning the process of writing the draft plan. A brief two-sided overview is being produced for wider circulation over the coming months.

A meeting of the Environment, History and Character working group met to discuss the next stages of the work stream and to begin a process of information and evidence capture. The meeting welcomed a representative from North Worcestershire Water Management who gave the group a detailed guide into the role and responsibilities of the department, Historic England, and the Environment Agency. Valuable advice was given in respect of environmental enhancements and how the working group can influence stakeholders to bring betterment to Hagley. The group went on to discuss some of the work streams including country and historic walks in and around Hagley. It

was agreed that these walks need to be assessed as well as how aspirations to introduce new walks that joined up country pathways can be achieved. A request for volunteers to help with the 'legwork' and the physical environmental work that's required over the coming months was met with great support.

A Historic walk was carried out around the Hall and was attended by 8 volunteers. A further walk is planned for March at the same time as planning environmental assessment visits to the areas of land put forward as part of the planning authorities call for sites.

The aim is to define, protect, restore, and enhance the 'environment' within Hagley.




