HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

Our programme of talks pauses for a summer break in August, but our website remains live with a wide range of videos, photographs and documents uncovering the history of Hagley and our local area.

Talks resume on September 6th as we welcome professional historical performers 'Discover History' who will be presenting 'The Stone and Bronze Age in Worcestershire'. Prehistory is the longest period of human history, but the one we know least about. Over this time, Worcestershire underwent huge climactic, societal, political, technological and geological changes - including two ice ages! The lack of written records mean that historians rely upon archaeological

evidence (such as the Neolithic axehead featured in October 2021) to provide insight into everyday human experiences such as sourcing food, finding shelter and trading. Visitors are most welcome at all our events.

FREDA JAMES

Winifred Alice "Freda" James was a British female tennis player of the 1930s. She won the women's doubles in Grand Slam events three times in 1933 at the US Women's National Championship with Betty Nuthall and twice at Wimbledon in 1935 and 1936 with Kay Stammers). From 1931 to 1939, she was part of the British team in the Wightman Cup.

Local to Hagley, Freda lived at number 15, the bungalow on left if you're heading towards Newfield Road. She used to send my family (number 20) LTA xmas cards each year that only former Wimbledon players could send.

Hammersley became her surname upon marriage. The Hammersley's family business was a clothing wholesale factory and more information about this can be found at www.midlandpubs.co.uk/worcestershire/cradley Here there is also a newsreel 30 second video clip of Freda playing in the Wightman Cup in the USA circa 1939.

AUGUST: The History of Christianity is littered with illustrations of the lives of the virtuous and, it must be recognised, the villainous. There are many important historical dates in August which changed Christian lives. On the 17th, John Wesley summoned ministers to a conference to urge them to go and preach in America. It led to the establishment of Methodism as the largest Protestant denomination there. On the 5th August the Pilgrim Fathers departed to the New World. The 29th is traditionally the date of the beheading of john the Baptist. On the 23rd, a massacre of Protestants in France began and lasted several weeks. The month takes its name in honour of the 1st Roman Emperor, Augustus. Let us hope and pray that lessons can be learned from those who have shown us in the past and present how lives should be lead and encouragement received from the lives of Christians who have advanced the cause of Jesus Christ to all generations.
