HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On February 7th Mary Bodfish returns for what is sure to be an entertaining talk 'Singularities of Bodfish'. Mary began working over 40 years ago on the question of "How come I was landed with the name of Bodfish?" Hear how Mary researched her family history, as well as the usual agricultural labourers, she shares tales of a village idiot, a prize-fighter, a jailbird, a gold prospector, a multi-millionaire – not to mention the whaling captains and the eskimos! Mary is a founder member and Chair of the Smethwick Local History Society and has taught local history research and palaeography for the University of Birmingham's School of Continuing Studies.

On March 7th, the Chairman of Clent History Society, Paul Timmins returns to present 'Clent Village: A Brief Look Back (Part 2)' The talk promises to be interesting for anyone familiar with Clent and wanting to spot the history hidden around us. The talk includes many pictures from the Society's archive and photos taken by Paul over a period of years, documenting changes in the village and surrounding area.

HAGLEY STRING ORCHESTRA

The playing of string instruments began in Spain in the middle of the 16th century at about the same time as the Bach family in Germany started composing. Some of the earliest string instruments are viols which have frets and are played on the knee. However, in northem Italy at Cremona, violins and violas (both held under the chin), cellos and basses were being developed, the most famous makers being the Stradivari family. This was also the period of the rise of the Bach family in Germany. Fast forward to J S Bach (1685-1750) who married twice and fathered 20 children.

One of his eldest was Carl Philipp Emanuel Bach (1714-1788) who was taught to play the clavier by his father. CPE obtained a degree in law at Leipzig University but, having obtained a post in Berlin serving Crown Prince Frederick of Prussia, he concentrated on composition. CPE Bach is of special interest to us at Hagley as he is one of the first composers to write symphonies for strings in several movements.

He had written some while in Berlin and then in Hamburg where he took over from his godfather Telemann as a director of music. We are playing one of these in C major, which has three movements (unlike the standard classical symphony with four) - a lively Allegro leading into an emotional Adagio and ending with a spritely Allegretto.





Meanwhile it looks like the criminal fraternity have been active once again in Hagley. As always it pays to be always vigilant and not make it any easier for unwanted visitors.

A driver was stopped and arrested on Sweetpool Lane early hours on 20th December for drug driving. An investigation is underway.

Good news that the stolen Hagley Scout's minibus was found and returned to them relatively quickly.

Eleven men have been convicted of burglary offences after appearing at Worcester Crown Court. The convicted men were all arrested

following a spate of 'car key' burglaries in North Worcestershire between December 2019 and 2020. In total, the investigation was into 47 reported burglaries which were carried out on homes to steal the keys to vehicles, which would then be stolen.

There were two burglaries in Sweetpool Lane; one c20:10hrs on 13th December and the other 2:20am on 11th December. On both occasions the offenders forced entry to the home by smashing the patio door. One vehicle was stolen but later retrieved because it had a tracker installed

A car that was stolen in Hagley was stopped by Police. 4 males were detained, arrested, and taken into custody. Found in their vehicle was a relay device and a knife.

Do you recall a 1980's scandal involving a local company concerning the supply of components to Iraq for a super-gun? We were intrigued to hear from the "horse's mouth" full details of the project and its political and legal outcome. Speaker, Derek Somers, grandson of Walter, the founder of Walter Somers Forge in Halesowen, was Sales Director in 1988. This was when an order was received from Saddam Hussein's Iraq for the construction of a tube allegedly for use in the petrochemical industry. The staff of Walter Somers were in little doubt the order was for a missile application rather than chemical plant and sought advice from MP Hal Miller regarding security clearance. Verbal approval was given by Government and the order was accepted and completed. However, in 1990 Customs

and Excise halted the shipment. This resulted in the Directors of Walter Somers being questioned and dismissed; their passports seized, and prison sentences imposed. The Scott Enquiry, which was held in 1996, resulted in the sentences being quashed.




