Local historian and retired master at Bromsgrove School, Philip Bowen will be presenting a talk about a fondly remembered decade 'Britain in the Fifties, The Optimistic Decade' on Tuesday 6th June. The 1950s were a time of unparalleled prosperity for many people. Harold Macmillan famously said, 'most of our people have never had it so good', in July 1957. The comments of the prime minister quickly came to represent the spirit of the day, encapsulating the optimism of a country. However, like many political quotes it is often misunderstood, Macmillan meant them not as an expression of complacency, but as a warning. 'What is worrying us,' he went on, 'is it too good to be true?'. Philip's illustrated talk will rekindle memories for those of a 'certain

age' and tell the story of a decade of social and technological change, shopping, teenagers and of course, rock and roll!



HAGLEY STRING ORCHESTRA

We're enjoying a varied programme of music this Summer Term. This includes Grieg's Holberg Suite and works by Hindemith, William Lawes, Mendelssohn, Rameau, Sibelius and Schubert. Our chamber work is Dvořák's second Quintet which includes a part for the Double Bass. The Norwegian composer Edvard Grieg (1843-1907) was born in Bergen, his mother being a music teacher who taught him the piano when he was six; his paternal ancestors were Scottish. When he was 15 he was advised to study music at Leipzig Conservatoire, but he disliked the college discipline. He eventually became a concert pianist and met both Liszt and Tchaikovsky. He was awarded honorary doctorates at both Cambridge and Oxford Universities, and in 1897 he gave a private concert at Windsor Castle for Queen Victoria. Grieg's 5-movement Holberg Suite was initially written for piano; he later transcribed it for string orchestra. Grieg is probably best known for his Peer Gynt Suites and the popular Piano Concerto in A minor.
