HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

There is no meeting in August for the Historical Society. We meet again on 5th September when we welcome Michael Loftus presenting 'Mr Mitchell's Quite Wonderful Wall' If you've driven in Kidderminster, you're sure to have noticed the extensive concrete relief decorating the retaining wall from Worcester Cross to Worcester Road Ring Road. William Mitchell (1925-2020) was a prolific and innovative architectural sculptor who worked in various materials but most notably concrete. Mitchell was particularly keen to give the wall elements which passers-by might find attractive and interesting. Mr Loftus and fellow members of the Civic Society campaigned for the 'Great Wall of Kidderminster' to receive listed status and after years of neglect, it

is now recognised for its artistic merit and was awarded Grade II status in 2020. One of the detailed panels designed to provide a backdrop for a waterfall was also reinstated in 2021, bringing happy memories to many in the town. The society's meetings which are held at 8pm in St Saviour's hall on the first Tuesday of each month. Visitors are most welcome at all our events.





HAGLEY NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

A continued success of the public meeting with the Police and Crime Commissioner and his team earlier this year is the increase in the number of speed enforcement checks.

I can confirm that these checks have been extended to Brake Lane and include Newfield Rd, Middlefield Lane, and at the B4187, Worcester Road. These are in addition to the checks already carried out on the A456. These checks will be carried out on an adhoc basis as and when Police resources allow it and of course it won't totally stop speeding traffic but the increase in the number of checks does go towards speed awareness and delivering the message that safe driving through Hagley is being encouraged. My thanks go to the Hagley and Rubery Policing

Team for continuing to commit to promises made at the public meeting. I continue to chase the Safer Roads Partnership on actions agreed at the Safer Roads Working Group meeting. Site visits were agreed to assess the public concerns raised at this meeting and to return with an action plan.

Finally, a reminder to ask friends and neighbours to keep a watchful eye on your property whilst you're away. Prevention is better than cure and keeping your property safe from opportunistic thieves is vitally important at any time of the year.

HAGLEY STRING ORCHESTRA

Together with music composed specifically for string orchestra, each term we also play as a group chamber works that were written for solo players such as string quartets. Quartets are usually without a part for a double bass, which is why last term our major item was a String Quintet by Dvořák, which has an essential double bass part.

Antonin Dvořák (1841-1904) was a Czech composer who joined his father in a folk music group playing the violin at the age of six! At 16 he was studying piano, organ, singing and music theory in Prague where he became influenced by Wagner's music. Two years later he was in the orchestra of the National Theatre being conducted by Smetana and Wagner. Dvořák is best known for his popular 'From the New World' Symphony (commissioned by the New York Philharmonic Orchestra) and his Requiem which was premiered in Birmingham Town Hall in 1891. He travelled to Birmingham from London many times, loving the steam railway journey.

He wrote his String Quintet No.2 in 1875 when he was 34. It's a technically demanding work of wonderful music which we have enjoyed playing.

HAGLEY VILLAGE ALLOTMENTS

July was a wonderful month in the garden and at the allotment. Summer is now in full flow, and you'll be beginning to reap the rewards of all the hard work you've been putting in.

But all that lush summer abundance can turn to chaos if you don't stay on top of things. Here is some advice from the Hagley allotmenteers:

- Keep up with watering and keep on weeding says Plot 31. Plants need more water than ever at this time of year and being "water wise" will certainly help. Mulch around your plants to reduce moisture loss from the soil or use a drip irrigation system. As for weeding, little and often is generally best.
- For those strawberry growers at home and on the plot, Plot 30's advice is to use straw underneath your plants. This gives the fruiting bodies a nice, comfy bed, helps to stop any bruising or sitting on wet soil.

- Plot 18 says to reap the rewards from fruit trees and bushes, master pruning in conjunction with the seasons. Pruning at the wrong time could see you losing harvests before they have begun.
- Don't be afraid to ask for help or advice, in the garden or on the plot. Ask your neighbour or pop a plea on the Love Hagley Facebook page.
- Plot 10a gives us reassuring advice to not feel overwhelmed when taking on an overgrown plot or if the garden feels like a daunting task.
 Break it down into small, achievable tasks and do a bit at a time. Think about what's going to benefit you in the short term and start that.




