HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On 5th September we welcome Michael Loftus presenting 'Mr Mitchell's Quite Wonderful Wall'

If you've driven in Kidderminster, you're sure to have noticed the extensive concrete relief decorating the retaining wall from Worcester Cross to Worcester Road on the Ring Road. William Mitchell (1925-2020) was a prolific and innovative architectural sculptor who worked in various materials but most notably concrete. Mitchell was particularly keen to give the wall elements which passers-by might find attractive and interesting.

Mr Loftus and fellow members of the Civic Society campaigned for the 'Great Wall of Kidderminster' to receive listed status and after years of neglect, it is now recognised for its artistic merit and was awarded Grade II status in 2020. One of the detailed panels designed to provide a backdrop for a waterfall was also reinstated in 2021, bringing happy memories to many in the town. On 3rd October we have a very short AGM followed by Ned Williams presenting 'Here Comes the Circus!'

Ned is a local historian and the author of several books including 'Fairs and Circuses in the Black Country' and 'Midland Fairground Families'. This talk promises to take us from the legends of circus history through to a survey of the lively, modern circus scene.

The society's meetings which are held at 8pm in St Saviour's hall on the first Tuesday of each month. Visitors are most welcome at all our events.







Kay Wilkinson of Hagley

There has been a building on the plot of 157 Worcester Road since the 1930s. Records show that this had been a dress shop for many years and up to 1963 Mrs Myra Crumpton owned a Ladies' and Gents' outfitters in that building. Then Kay Wilkinson ran her business there from 1963 until 1964.

Recent refurbishments to the building included adding more facilities for the dental practice that is currently there. During that rebuilding work the Kay Wilkinson shop sign pictured here was found and photographed. This item is at least 59 years old and might be familiar to some of our older residents.

There are over 1200 species of bat and not a single one of them is blind! In fact, they have amazing eyesight being able to see in what we would consider pitch darkness.


We live our lives with many of these incorrectly held presumptions, never knowing the truth just because we accept the commonly held opinion. What else might we presume to be true about life that might surprise us?

HAGLEY VILLAGE ALLOTMENTS

Welcome to September as we start the onset of autumn! At this time of year on the allotment or those who grow at home, it may be the last month for courgettes, French and runner beans, tomatoes and such but on the other hand, later crops like autumn raspberries, leeks and main top potatoes could becoming into fruition. You may even have your first Brussels sprouts! All is not lost though as there is still the last chance to sow spinach, winter lettuce, rocket and hardy oriental leaves-under cloches if need be.

September is a good time to add everything you can to your compost heap-making sure what you add is disease free. Don't forget to give it a good 'turn' to aerate and stimulate decomposition, watering your heap of its dry, and cover to keep it warm. A sheet of plastic or an old piece of carpet should do the trick.

This month it's favourable to prune any blackberries and hybrid berries you may have on the allotment or at home. Prune canes that have borne this years fruit, take out any old or dead wood and remember to leave new canes unpruned for next years fruit. It's also a great month to order any new bareroot fruit trees and bushes in time for planting in November. The local garden centres and nurseries will have a wide choice this time of the year.

And for the flower lovers out there, now is the time to stop fertilising, cut back any perennials that have finished blooming, divide and move perennials to fill any gaps, start digging up and store tender bulbs like, dahlias and cannas and start planting spring bulbs such as daffodils, tulips and hyacinths.




