





UPCOMING MEETINGS

On 3rd October we have a very short AGM followed by Ned Williams presenting 'Here Comes the Circus!'

Ned is a local historian and the author of several books including 'Fairs and Circuses in the Black Country' and 'Midland Fairground Families'. This talk promises to take us from the legends of circus history through to a survey of the lively, modern circus scene.

On November 7th we welcome Bob Booth presenting 'The Sweet Life in Bournville'.

In 1879 George and Richard Cadbury, makers of chocolate and cocoa moved their factory from Birmingham city centre to the healthier environment of the countryside. They named their new village Bournville and planned a model village of well-built cottages with large gardens for their workers. The village would also have spaces for recreation and leisure.

Pictures from personal collections will be used in his presentation and aspects of the Cadbury legacy, the village architecture, the community, and some of the lesser-known facts about Bournville will be revealed.

The society's meetings which are held at 8pm in St Saviour's hall on the first Tuesday of each month.

Visitors are most welcome at all our events.



A meeting was held with the surgery's senior Clinician and management team where we discussed a wide range of issues including.

'Home instead' is offering free dementia awareness training across Hagley and the offer is being extended to members of the PPG. If you would like to take advantage of this free training, please contact 'Home Instead'.

The surgery has received its results from the national NHS patient Survey 2023. Overall, it is very pleased with the scoring and proud of the service it offers to our patients. This is great news and on behalf of the PPG I congratulate Hagley surgery for a splendid set of results making it the highest scoring surgery in the Wyre Forest group.

There will be no further covid clinics at Hagley Surgery this annum. Clinic's will run centrally from Kidderminster Medical Centre and Stourport Medical Centre. Flu clinics will

run Saturday 23rd September and Saturday 7th October (08:00am-14:00pm). Qualifying patients will be contacted directly to arrange an appointment.

The surgery has 2 new GP trainees that have joined for a 12-month period. Dr Henry Duru and Tolulope Kazeem (both Male) will be working Mon/Tue/Wed/Fri, as well as 2 medical students commencing placement early September. (Both Female) working Mon/Wed/Thurs.

Hagley Surgery is a 'War Veteran' accredited practice. Dr Ayodele Ola is the GP veteran coordinator for the practice. On Friday 10th November it will be handing out envelopes of poppy seeds at Reception to mark the occasion.

More details will be made available soon in relation to how the surgery manages patient's triage.

HAGLEY NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

I thought I would let you know that PC Marc Ginder is leaving the Policing Neighbourhood Team and will be posted in Bewdley, as is PCSO Sue White who is moving to Stourport. I wish them both well and thank them for their help and support over the last several year and look forward to welcoming their replacements in due course.

We have seen a spate of burglaries over the summer and criminals targeting Range Rovers. As always, we need to be vigilant not only for our own property but for our neighbours too.

There was an incident in Middlefield Lane, during 24th August where a front window of the property was broken and the wires to the alarm system 'cut'.

Prior to that a burglary overnight on Worcester Close occurred where a blue Range Rover partial reg CVZ was stolen with keys and three watches.

A burglary took place on Hoarstone between 1:30am - 2:30am 26th July. The 2 offenders were tall, dressed in black coats with hoods up and left in a white sporty car where two more offenders were waiting.

A further burglary to an outbuilding on Brake Lane occurred where the offenders have come through the roof and have stolen 2 chainsaws.

These latest incidents show that Hagley remains vulnerable to the criminal fraternity. I am in regular contact with the Policing Teams and asked for greater patrols are undertaken throughout the day and night to discourage these all too frequent incidents.

It transpired he had also been a busy stud dog having sired 400 puppies including with bitches in Holland and America – so he deserved to sleep!

Carol is an active participant in "Guide Dogs for the Blind" having started as a puppy walker 40 years ago. She described the infinite patience necessary in training dogs to cope with all foreseen circumstances, so that eventually they provided freedom and companionship to people with impaired or no vision. The puppies are bred in homes and after 6-7 weeks they go to the national breeding centre in Leamington, from where they go for about 6 months of intensive training. Eventually

they are gradually introduced to prospective owners through "sleep overs". If the puppy and potential recipient match they go to a hotel for 2 weeks for further bonding. The cost of this incredible process which enriches the lives of their owners' costs £55,000 per dog, financed by public donations.
