

HAGLEY HISTORICAL AND FIELD SOCIETY

On 5th March we welcomed Alan Peace who presented 'Himley Hall, Past, Present and Future' For many years, Himley Hall belonged to successive Earls of Dudley. The Hall began as a Hunting Lodge and after many redevelopments it steadily grew into the grand house we see today. Between 1920 and 1936 it was so grand that Edward, Prince of Wales, later to become King Edward VIII. frequently visited the house for weekend shooting parties, he also made use of the indoor swimming pool, which was equipped with a water chute and cocktail bar! Alan shared the stories of the house and park, gathered over 27 years' experience as a Himley Park Ranger.

On 2nd April we welcome the return of Mary Bodfish who will be sharing 'How we lived then'. History is full of the stories of the rich and powerful, with much less being known about the lives of 'ordinary' people. One way we can

learn snapshots about the lives and homes of our forebears is through probate inventories. In this talk, Mary will use inventories to take a "time machine" tour round the house of a late 17th-century yeoman - and see in detail how his hard-working family cooked, dined, slept, cleaned, and clothed themselves.

The society's meetings are held at 8pm in St Saviour's Hall on the first Tuesday of each month. Visitors are most welcome at all our events.



We nervously peeled back the tarpaulins on our plot this weekend (end of February) after four months of coverage (and rain) since we first took it on – not really knowing what we would uncover or what we would be dealing with.

Safe to say the wet winter seemed endless but we were pleasantly surprised by what we found; well drained, earthworm laden soil which was ripe and ready for planting!

We have now broken ground and planted three types of onions and shallots. We've gone for a hardier Japanese variety called Shenshyu onions, Jermor shallots originating from the Southern Rhône Valley and then of course a classic red onion called Electric. Obviously we're hoping the full sun of the Southern Rhône is manifested in Hagley also!

When planning what to grow for our first season, we focussed on two main objectives produce that we would enjoying cooking and gifting – plus of course the Christmas Day table for 2024 as mentioned last month. One book I have really enjoyed reading is called "From the Veg Patch" by Kathy Slack. What is particularly lovely about the book is the ten chapters based on produce that I imagine encompass the top 10 of many a happy allotmenteer's plot – can you guess what they are? Answers below!

We hope you enjoy the early spring sunshine and the (slightly) lighter nights and we look forward to the next update!



HAGLEY HOBBLERS

In April Hagley Hobblers Walking Football Group celebrates its second anniversary of weekly walking football sessions on Hagley Playing Fields. The group, now largely self run, was established in 2022 under a wider walking football initiative by Bromsgrove and Redditch District Council, with support from Hagley Parish Council. Initial funding paid for the necessary equipment (footballs, playing bibs etc). The group was brought together and run for the first 3 months by volunteer Alex Cooke and since then has been largely self run with District and Parish Council support. The facilities at Hagley Playing Fields, both the Pavilion and the plaving fields, are provided by Hagley Parish Council, and West Hagley Football Club supply goal posts and flags.

A dozen players took part on the first day, Tuesday 19 April 2022, many of whom have become regulars. Since then games have taken place every Tuesday at 10.30am (weather permitting, though the group has generally been quite fortunate with the weather!). Everyone turning up is guaranteed a game, as the number in each team and the size of the pitch is adjusted accordingly. The only rule is 'just turn up on Tuesday for 10.30am' - no prior notice or future commitment required. The rules of walking football are fairly simple, with some appropriate adjustments from ordinary football - mainly 'no running'!


